

means of judicial remedies or compensation Therefore many discriminatory practices are not reported to school administrations. The entire education system is based on Turkishness Non Turkish groups are either not referred to or referred in a negative way says Kaya Education system has played a significant role in deepening conflict in society. The positive representation of other groups in the education system would contribute to social peace and harmony.
