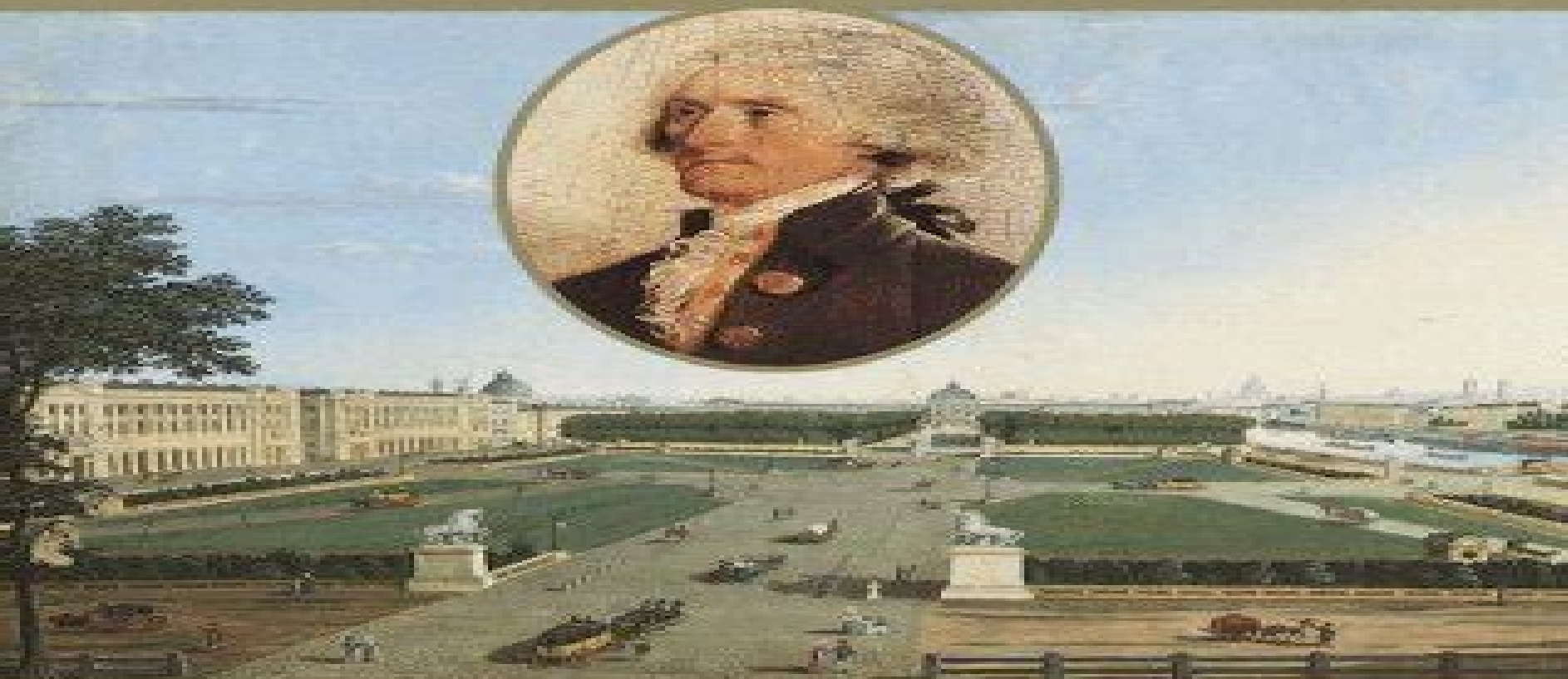

Thomas Jefferson suffered during his life from periodic bouts of dejection and despair, shadowed intervals during which he was full of gloomy forebodings about what lay ahead. Not long before he composed the Declaration of Independence, the young Jefferson lay for six weeks in idleness and ill health at Monticello, paralyzed by a mysterious malady. Jefferson, as we have rarely seen him before, The worst of these moments came after his wife died in 1782. He set out for the palms and temples of southern Europe, and though he did not know where the therapeutic journey would take him or where it would end, his encounter with the old civilizations of the Mediterranean was transformative. Jefferson's immersion in the mystic truths of the Old World gave him insights into mysteries of life and art that Enlightenment philosophy had failed to supply. McDonald,2023-05-08 Poplar Forest is one of two personal residences that Thomas Jefferson designed for himself the other being Monticello Jefferson s wife Martha Wayles Skelton Jefferson inherited the land originally a 6 861 acre parcel at her father s death in 1773 but Jefferson did not begin construction on the house until 1806 and at his death in 1826 he was still working on his little getaway Despite its audacious design it was the first documented octagonal residence in America and the fact that it is one of the very few extant Jeffersonian structures Poplar Forest is not nearly so well known today as its sibling seventy miles to the northeast Undoubtedly this is due in large part to its more remote location in Bedford County Additionally the house remained in private hands until 1984 Travis McDonald situates the site in its rightful position as a historically important Virginia house and he documents its story as central to Jefferson s life and approach to architecture including details of the enslaved community at his western retreat This new informed account will appeal to architectural historians and visitors to the villa retreat as well as to those interested in Jefferson s work and legacy In Search of

history Focusing on authors who explicitly connect the empire abroad and the empire at home James Weldon Johnson Sutton Griggs Pauline E Hopkins W E B Du Bois and others Gruesser examines U S black participation in support for and resistance to expansion Race consistently trumped empire for African American writers who adopted positions based on the effects they believed expansion would have on blacks at home Given the complexity of the debates over empire and rapidity with which events in the Caribbean and the Pacific changed in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries it should come as no surprise that these authors often did not maintain fixed positions on imperialism Their stances depended on several factors including the foreign location the presence or absence of African American soldiers within a particular text the stage of the author s career and a given text s relationship to specific generic and literary traditions No matter what their disposition was toward imperialism the fact of U S expansion allowed and in many cases compelled black writers to grapple with empire They often used texts about expansion to address the situation facing blacks at home during a period in which their citizenship rights and their very existence were increasingly in jeopardy

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
