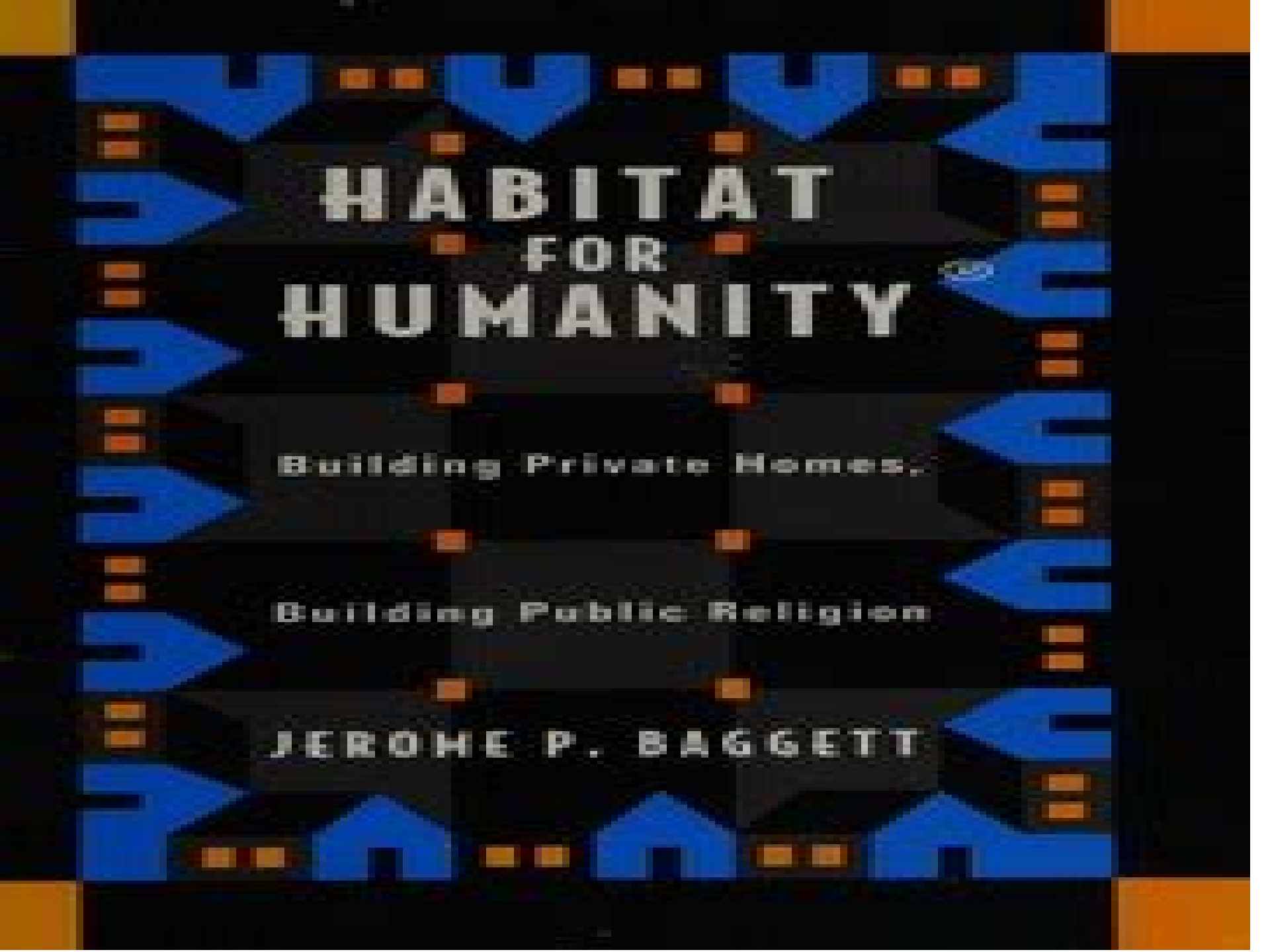

influences it as they pursue their individual paths Drawing on three years of interview survey and participant observation data Catholic Activism Today offers a compelling new take on contemporary dynamics of Catholic civic engagement and its potential effect on the Church at large
