Payne,2014-07-11 In 1938 Prime Minister Neville Chamberlain hoped that a policy of appeasement would satisfy Adolf Hitler s territorial appetite and structured British policy accordingly This plan was a failure chiefly because Hitler was not a statesman who would ultimately conform to familiar norms Chamberlain s policy was doomed because he had greatly

misjudged Hitler's basic beliefs and thus his behavior. U.S. Cold War nuclear deterrence policy was similarly based on the confident but questionable assumption that Soviet leaders would be rational by Washington's standards; they would behave reasonably when presented with nuclear threats. The United States assumed that any sane challenger would be deterred from severe provocations because not to do so would be foolish. Keith B.
