

Ludwig Wittgenstein Ray Monk,1990 Ludwig Wittgenstein is perhaps the greatest philosopher of the twentieth century and certainly one of the most original in the entire Western tradition Given the inaccessibility of his work it is remarkable that he has inspired poems paintings films musical compositions titles of books and even novels In his splendid biography Ray Monk has made this very compelling human being come alive in a way that perfectly explains the fascination he has evoked Wittgenstein s life was one of great moral and spiritual depth Although his work addresses problems of logic language mind and knowledge he often described it as having an ethical point and once said that he could not help seeing every problem from a religious point of view In successfully bridging the gap assumed by many to exist between Wittgenstein s life and his work Monk s biography helps to explain the interest in Wittgenstein s later philosophy on the part of Buddhist scholars
