housing conditions and costs of different sections of the community A major theme is that British and American governments contrary to their stated objectives have actually increased housing inequality by allowing homeowners tax concessions which are more generous than the housing welfare programmes available to tenants The political pressures which produced this outcome in Britain and the USA but a quite different and more egalitarian outcome in Sweden are carefully discussed Throughout the book policy making is regarded as involving trade offs between what is politically feasible and what is operationally feasible This framework enables readers to view policy making from the perspective of politicians and civil servants as they react to diverse demands and pressures and seek to devise housing programmes which embody incentives to which housing financiers builders and consumers will respond
