employed by self praising speakers who want to preempt their listeners loathing The book is therefore a useful addition to the burgeoning secondary literature on ancient emotions Despite the prominence of emotions in classicists scholarly work their implications for persuasion is undeservedly under researched By employing appraisal oriented analysis of emotions this books suggests new methodological approaches to ancient pathopoiia These approaches take into consideration the wider ideological or cultural contexts which determine individual speakers rhetorical strategies This book is the second volume of Ancient Emotions edited by George Kazantzidis and Dimos Spatharas within the series Trends in Classics Supplementary Volumes This project investigates the history of emotions in classical antiquity providing a home for interdisciplinary approaches to ancient emotions and exploring the inter faces between emotions and significant aspects of ancient literature and culture
