Jamestown 1622 Cameron Colby, 2024-06-20 A dramatic illustrated exploration of the infamous massacre of 1622 and the events of a pivotal conflict in colonial American history From the establishment of Jamestown in 1607 English settlers in Virginia maintained a shaky relationship with the Powhatan Confederacy As the settlers expanded their profitable tobacco fields bolstered by new supplies and people each year Powhatan tribes grew increasingly wary of English power In 1622 Chief Opechancanough shattered the peace with surprise simultaneous attacks on Jamestown and its surrounding settlements during which 347 English settlers one third of the Virginia colony were killed in a single day Opechancanough hoped to eliminate the European presence with a decisive blow but instead began a decade long war with Jamestown In this engaging and expertly researched work Cameron Colby narrates the tumultuous events of the colony's early years Engagements between 1607 and 1632 are brought vividly to life using battlescene artworks and period images Detailed maps and 3D diagrams illustrate Native American and English tactics and chart the progress of Jamestown's expansion as English settlers sought to drive back the Powhatan tribes of the Chesapeake [Where a Hundred Soldiers Were Killed](#) John H. Monnett, 2008 Monnett takes a closer look at the struggle between the mining interests of the United States and the Lakota and Cheyenne nations in 1866 that climaxed with the Fetterman Massacre [Massacring Indians](#) Roger L. Nichols, 2021-03-04 During the nineteenth century the U S military fought numerous battles against American Indians These so called Indian wars devastated indigenous populations and some of the conflicts stand out today as massacres as they involved violent attacks on often defenseless Native communities including women and children Although historians have written full length studies about each of these episodes *Massacring Indians* is the first to present them as

part of a larger pattern of aggression perpetuated by heartless or inept military commanders In clear and accessible prose veteran historian Roger L Nichols examines ten significant massacres committed by U S Army units against American Indians The battles range geographically from Alabama to Montana and include such well known atrocities as Sand Creek Washita and Wounded Knee Nichols explores the unique circumstances of each event including its local context At the same time looking beyond the confusion and bloodshed of warfare he identifies elements common to all the massacres Unforgettable details emerge in the course of his account inadequate training of U S soldiers overeagerness to punish Indians an inflated desire for glory among individual officers and even careless mistakes resulting in attacks on the wrong village or band As the author chronicles the collective tragedy of the massacres he highlights the roles of well known frontier commanders ranging from Andrew Jackson to John Chivington and George Armstrong Custer In many cases Nichols explains it was lower ranking officers who bore the responsibility and blame for the massacres even though orders came from the higher ups During the nineteenth century and for years thereafter white settlers repeatedly used the term massacre to describe Indian raids rather than the reverse They lacked the understanding to differentiate such raids Indians defending their homeland against invasion from the aggressive decimation of peaceful Indian villages by U S troops Even today it may be tempting for some to view the massacres as exceptions to the norm By offering a broader synthesis of the attacks *Massacring Indians* uncovers a more disturbing truth that slaughtering innocent people was routine practice for U S troops and their leaders **Inside**
