Coggeshall, 2018-04-10 In 2007, while researching mountain culture in upstate South Carolina, anthropologist John M. Coggeshall stumbled upon the small community of Liberia in the Blue Ridge foothills. There, he met Mable Owens Clarke and her family, the remaining members of a small African American community still living on land obtained immediately after the Civil War. This intimate history tells the story of five generations of the Owens family and their friends and neighbors, chronicling their struggles through slavery, Reconstruction, the Jim Crow era, and the desegregation of the state. Through hours of interviews with Mable and her relatives, as well as friends and neighbors, Coggeshall presents an ethnographic history that allows members of a largely ignored community to speak and record their own history for the first time. This

Hutslar, 1992 Log construction entered the Ohio territory with the seventeenth century fur traders and mid eighteenth century squatters and then spread throughout most of the area after the opening of the territory in the 1780s Scottish Irish and German settlers using techniques from the eastern states and European homelands found the abundant timber resources of the Ohio country ideally suited to this simple durable form of construction Hutslar documents this early architecture with extensive descriptive materials from local histories diaries traveller's accounts building contracts and many recent site photographs These descriptions will be interesting for modern craftsmen and other builders involved in historic restoration or log construction generally Hutslar's extensive fieldwork is valuable to students of vernacular architecture and preservationists and this abridged paperback edition of his book is a boon to travelling or local history buffs who can refer to this wealth of information at their leisure **Southern Exposure**, 1980 *Library Journal*, 1995

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
