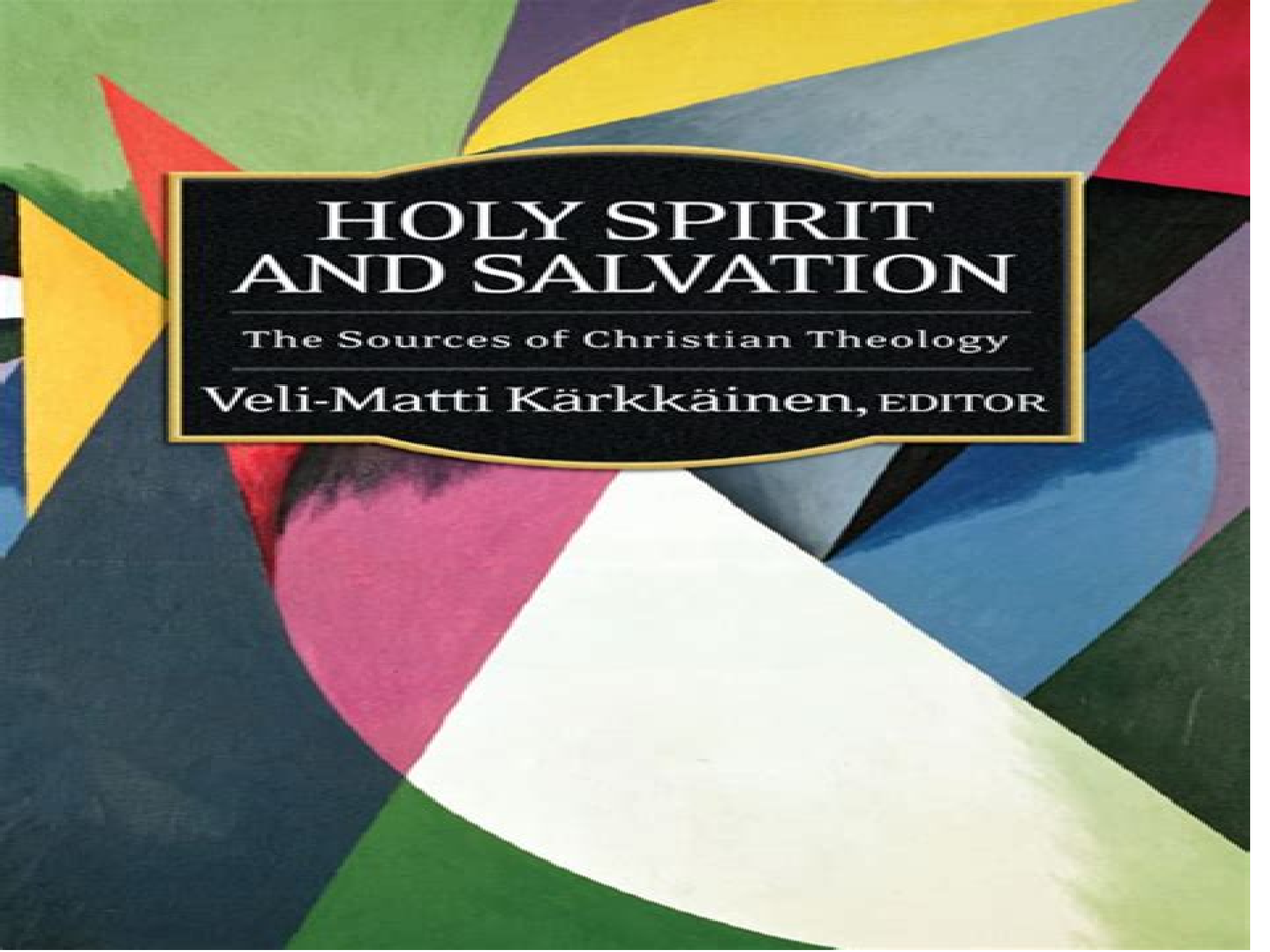

The Holy Spirit -- In Biblical Teaching, Through the Centuries, and Today Anthony C. Thiselton, 2013-06 The book is divided into three parts Part One provides a thematic analysis and exegetical commentary on all the relevant biblical and cognate literature including Josephus Philo and the Mishnah Part Two investigates the thinking of key Christian theologians on the Holy Spirit from the Apostolic Fathers to eighteenth century authors such as John Wesley and Jonathan Edwards Part Three examines more recent writings on the Spirit from the nineteenth century onwards including major systematic theologians such as Schleiermacher Barth and Moltmann as well as biblical scholars such as James D G Dunn Gordon Fee and Gerd Theissen Thiselton concludes the entire study by identifying seven fundamental themes and calling for greater dialogue between mainstream scholarship and contemporary leaders of the Pentecostal and Renewal movements

The Doctrine of the Holy Spirit Jacob Godebo, 2025-07-03 The Scriptures teach the church that in biblical times the coming of the Holy Spirit equally entailed objective gift of divine reality and subjective experience of his presence gifts and works There was objective pouring out and imparting of the Holy Spirit from the divine side and subjective experiential demonstration from the receivers side which resulted from the gifts endowed and power imparted along with the Holy Spirit Having given them either verbally uttered or visibly performed gifts the Holy Spirit then moved believers towards practical demonstration through subjective experience Believers subjective experience took place only as a result of the objective gift of the Holy Spirit and the resulting endowment and empowerment Thus in the objective content of his manifestation the Holy Spirit is the objective gift of God to indwell his people In the subjective content of his manifestation the Holy Spirit endows people with audibly uttered or visibly performed gifts The subjective experience of the Holy Spirit s presence therefore is an original theological input from God just like the objective impartation of the Holy Spirit Practitioners were just objects of divine purpose and their subjective experience was divine provided and divine initiated genuine experience beyond their consciousness and calculation Reception of the Holy Spirit therefore means equally an experience of his presence gifts power and works in the church and in with and through believers from Hosanna to Maranatha

Describing Jesus as an agent of divine actions or as one who possesses human agency is commonplace in christological discussions. Yet these discussions often wade in a shallow understanding of the terms' meanings and the theological implications of such claims. For example, while many theologians who are committed to the definition of Chalcedon consider Jesus one agent, we might ask if this implies that the triune God comprises three agents. Or if Christ possesses singular agency, how are his divinity and humanity operative in his actions? In response, this work draws from the theology of John Owen and advancements in philosophy of action in order to offer an account of divine and human agency in christological action from within the Reformed tradition. It provides clarity to the christological and trinitarian uses of the language of agent agency in Christ and attends to the theological esp. trinitarian entailments therein. While at first glance there may appear to be internal inconsistencies with accounts that subscribe to classical trinitarianism and Reformed Christological agency, this book argues that Owen helps us recover an understanding of christological agency that is internally coherent and theologically prudent. As such, the Reformed tradition can articulate Christological agency in a way that is coherent with the testimony of Scripture, the ecumenical councils and classical trinitarianism while contributing to contemporary theological discussions. The case not only provides terminological clarity and theological coherence but also

inclines Christians to appreciate the trinitarian love of God in Christ's action and the human sympathy of Christ for his people

And in Our Hearts Take Up Thy Rest Michael Eades, 2019-07-15 In his seminary classes and his writings Frederick Crowe SJ 1915-2012 sought to understand anew the eternal identity of the Holy Spirit and the Spirit's role in the Church's life Despite Crowe's fame as a professor of Trinitarian theology and his groundbreaking work on Thomas Aquinas's doctrine of complacent love as an analogy for the Holy Spirit's eternal procession no book has ever been published on this influential Canadian Jesuit who established centres around the world dedicated to studying the theological writings of Bernard Lonergan SJ 1904-84 Drawing on Crowe's published works and archival materials Eades emphasizes how Crowe's Trinitarian pneumatology creatively extended Lonergan's theology of the Holy Spirit Making use of Crowe's own historical methodology Eades looks for the emergence of new and significant questions about the Holy Spirit in Crowe's works

Rediscovering the Holy Spirit Michael Horton, 2017-04-25 For the Spirit being somewhat forgotten is an occupational hazard The Holy Spirit is so actively involved in our lives that we can take his presence for granted As they say familiarity breeds contempt Just as we take breathing for granted we can take the Holy Spirit for granted simply because we constantly depend on him Like the cane that soon feels like an extension of the blind man's own body we too easily begin to think of the Holy Spirit as an extension of ourselves Yet the Spirit is at the center of the action in the divine drama from Genesis 1:2 all the way to Revelation 22:17 The Spirit's work is as essential as the Father's and the Son's yet the Spirit's work is always directed to the person and work of Christ In fact the efficacy of the Holy Spirit's mission is measured by the extent to which we are focused on Christ The Holy Spirit is the person of the Trinity who brings the work of the Father in the Son to completion In everything that the Triune God performs this perfecting work is characteristic of the Spirit In *Rediscovering the Holy Spirit* author pastor and theologian Mike Horton introduces readers to the neglected person of the Holy Spirit showing that the work of God's Spirit is far more ordinary and common than we realize Horton argues that we need to take a step back every now and again to focus on the Spirit himself his person and work in order to recognize him as someone other than Jesus or ourselves much less something in creation Through this contemplation we can gain a fresh dependence on the Holy Spirit in every area of our lives

The Holy Spirit and Christian Experience Simeon Zahl, 2020-06-11 In *The Holy Spirit and Christian Experience* Simeon Zahl presents a fresh vision for Christian theology that foregrounds the relationship between theological ideas and the experiences of Christians He argues that theology is always operating in a vibrant landscape of feeling and desiring and shows that contemporary theology has often operated in problematic isolation from these experiential dynamics He then argues that a theologically serious doctrine of the Holy Spirit not only authorizes but requires attention to Christian experience Against this background Zahl outlines a new methodological approach to Christian theology that attends to the emotional and experiential power of theological ideas This methodology draws on recent interdisciplinary work on affect and emotion which has shown that affects are powerful motivating realities that saturate all dimensions of human thinking and

acting In the process Zahl also explains why contemporary theology has often been ambivalent about subjective experience and demonstrates that current discourse about God's activity in the world is often artificially abstracted from experience and embodiment At the heart of the book Zahl proposes a new account of the theology of grace from this experiential and pneumatological perspective Focusing on the work of the Holy Spirit in salvation and sanctification he retrieves insights from Augustine Luther and Philip Melancthon to present an affective and Augustinian vision of salvation as a pedagogy of desire In articulating this vision Zahl engages critically with recent emphasis on participation and theosis in Christian soteriology and charts a new path forward for Protestant theology in a landscape hitherto dominated by the theological visions of Barth and Aquinas
