In exploring this question particular attention is paid to the cohort families wealth household size education occupational history geographical mobility and broader involvement in society measured by their members choice of marriage partner their kinship and friendship circles their political allegiance and their leisure activities. The book demonstrates that male professionals in the Victorian era were far from being a homogenous group but were divided in many ways. The most important was wealth which played a key role in the social and occupational fortunes of their descendants. These divisions largely explain why some professionals and some individual professions were much more likely to display endogenous characteristics than others. The book also demonstrates that even the most successful professional families got poorer over time and reveals how easily in the age of industrialisation branches of families and sometimes complete families could drop out of the elite.
