

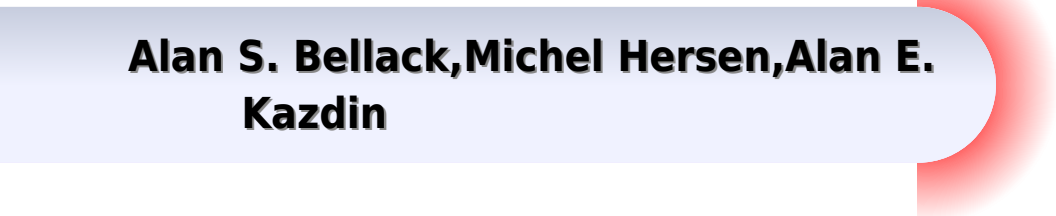

Additionally, patients with depression are at a greater risk for cardiovascular disease, stroke, functional impairment, disability, and all-cause mortality. Aside from the impact on the individual, this condition presents a very real economic burden as depression is the most predominant mental health problem among working age patients and the leading cause of lost work productivity. Despite advances in screening and treating depression in recent decades, a vast majority of patients with depression do not actively seek treatment, and of those that do, only a quarter have been found to receive adequate and effective interventions. *Handbook of Depression* Second Edition is a concise review of assessment tools available and emerging pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatment options and consensus management guidelines that center on enhancing the clinician-patient relationship and improving patient quality of life. Section 4 deals with psychological problems linked to physical health: health anxiety, somatization, chronic pain, adjustment to cancer, and eating disorders. Section 5 focuses on other significant psychological problems that come to the attention of clinical psychologists in adult mental health services: ADHD in adults, alcohol and other drug problems, psychosis, and psychological problems in older adults. Section 6 contains chapters on therapeutic approaches to psychological distress related to complex childhood trauma.
