Gregory Benford George Slusser, 2014-02-28 Gregory Benford is perhaps best known as the author of Benford's law of controversy. Passion is inversely proportional to the amount of real information available. That maxim is a quotation from Timescape. Benford's Nebula and Campbell Award winning 1980 novel which established his work as an exemplar of hard science fiction dedicated to working out the consequences of modern science rather than substituting pseudoscience for fantasy. Like many other current science fiction writers Benford has tackled the major genres: space travel, time travel, technology running amok, prolonged longevity, searing apocalyptic cosmic events, and alien life which he theorizes to be more likely viral than intelligent. An astrophysicist by training and profession Benford has published more than twenty novels over one hundred short stories, some fifty essays, and myriad articles that display both his scientific rigor as well as a recognition of literary traditions. In this study George Slusser explores the extraordinary seemingly inexhaustible display of creative energy in Gregory Benford's life and work. Presenting Benford's ideas on science and the writing of science fiction, the volume addresses the writer's literary production and his place in contemporary science fiction. By identifying direct sources and making parallels with other works and writers Slusser reveals the vast scope of Benford's knowledge both of literature and of the major scientific and philosophical issues of our time. Slusser also discusses Benford's numerous scientific articles and nonfiction books and includes a new interview with Benford.

Fiction Darren Harris-Fain, 2005 *Understanding Contemporary American Science Fiction The Age of Maturity 1970 2000* explores the major trends and developments during three decades that witnessed science fiction's most dramatic progression from subliterary escapist entertainment to a more sophisticated literature of ideas. Darren Harris-Fain suggests that to understand American science fiction fully it is essential to realize that the current field with all its variety results from the proceeding decades of writings. In addition, he contends that although much science fiction of merit was written in America prior to 1970, the latter decades of the twentieth century witnessed a dramatic improvement in quality even as the field fragmented into a variety of subgenres and as writers sought to transcend earlier critical dismissals. Harris-Fain discusses significant and representative works, most of which mainstream literary scholars and critics ignore, as he charts the historical and literary development of contemporary American science fiction, the internal divisions along both literary and political lines experienced during the Vietnam era, the influence of the feminist movement and other contemporary concerns, the increasing contributions of female, African American, and gay and lesbian writers, and the emergence of such significant trends as hard science fiction, cyberpunk, alternate history, and shared world stories. Harris-Fain also considers literary science fiction's relationship to the mass media, the effects the popularity of fantasy has on the field, and academia's continued misprizing of the genre.

Starlight Starbright: Are Stars Conscious? Second Edition Greg Matloff, C

Bangs, 2020-05-07 The only thing we can be absolutely sure of is our own consciousness. But what is consciousness? Is it a property that is unique to humans, or do we share it with other lifeforms? Or is the philosophical doctrine of panpsychism correct: are stars and the entire universe conscious in some sense? Early chapters in this book examine the prehistory, mythology, and history of this topic. Arguments are presented from the viewpoints of shamans, philosophers, poets, quantum physicists, and novelists. A simple toy model of panpsychism is then presented in which a universal field of proto-consciousness interacts with molecular bonds via the vacuum fluctuation pressure of the Casimir Effect. It is shown how this model is in congruence with an anomaly in stellar motions called Parenago's Discontinuity: cooler, redder, less massive stars such as the Sun apparently circle the center of the galaxy faster than their hotter, bluer, more massive sisters. This discontinuity occurs at the point in the stellar distribution where molecules begin to appear in stellar spectra. As described in the first edition of this book, observations of main sequence stars out to 260 light years and giant stars out to 1,000 light years using the ESA Hipparcos space observatory support the reality and non-locality of Parenago's Discontinuity. Local, more conventional explanations for this phenomenon are not supported by observations of other galaxies and the spiral arms of the Milky Way. Since 2014, the new ESA Gaia space observatory has been obtaining kinematics and position data for 1 billion stars in our galaxy. The first Gaia data release in 2016 has been used in 2018 by a Russian team to demonstrate Parenago's Discontinuity for a large stellar sample out to 500 light years from the Sun. These observations support the hypothesis that

anomalous stellar motion is due to stellar evolution as described by philosopher author Olaf Stapledon in his classic novel *Star Maker* as previously discussed by the author in the peer reviewed *Journal of the British Interplanetary Society JBIS* In light of the new Gaia observations and work by other researchers it is not impossible that panspsychism is emerging from the realm of philosophy as a new subdivision of observational astronomy Simple models of universal proto consciousness may be subject to inductive tests using current and future space observatories A special feature of this book is the chapter frontispiece art by C Bangs
