Great High Priest Margaret Barker, 2003-05-21 Margaret Barker has been researching and writing about the Jerusalem temple for over twenty years. Many of her studies have remained unpublished. Here for the first time her work on the roots of Christian liturgy has been brought together. Whereas most scholarship has concentrated upon the synagogue, Margaret Barker's work on the Jerusalem temple contributes significantly to our understanding of the meaning and importance of many elements of Christian liturgy which have hitherto remained obscure. This book opens up a new field of research. The many subjects addressed include the roots of the Eucharist in various temple rituals and offerings other than Passover, the meaning of the holy of holies and the Christian sanctuary, the cosmology of temple and church, the significance of the Veil of the Temple for understanding priesthood and Incarnation, the Holy Wisdom and the Mother of God, angels and priesthood, the concept of unity, the high priestly tradition in the early church, and evidence that Christianity was a conscious continuation of the temple. All scholars and students whose interest encompasses the origins of Christian and Orthodox liturgy, the Old Testament, early Christianity, Jewish-Christian relations, Platonism, and the origins of Islam will find this book a hugely rewarding source of information and new ideas.

The Great High Priest Margaret Barker, 2004 **Gregory of Nyssa's Tabernacle Imagery in Its Jewish and Christian Contexts** Ann Conway-Jones, 2014 Intergrating patristics and early Jewish mysticism, this book examines Gregory of Nyssa's tabernacle imagery as found in *Life of Moses* 2.170-201. Previous scholarship has often focused on Gregory's interpretation of the darkness on Mount Sinai as divine incomprehensibility. However, true to Exodus, Gregory continues with Moses's vision of the tabernacle not made with hands, received within that darkness. This innovative methodology of heuristic comparison doesn't strive to prove influence but to use heavenly ascent texts as a foil in order to shed new light on Gregory's imagery. Ann Conway-Jones presents a well-rounded, nuanced understanding of Gregory's exegesis in which mysticism, theology, and politics are intertwined. Heavenly ascent texts use descriptions of religious experience to claim authoritative knowledge. For Gregory, the high point of Moses's ascent into the darkness of Mount Sinai is the mystery of Christian doctrine. The heavenly tabernacle is a type of the heavenly Christ. This mystery is beyond intellectual comprehension; it can only be grasped by faith, and only the select few destined for positions of responsibility should even attempt to do so.

The Christological Metaphors of Wine, Water, and Bread in the Gospel of John in Relation to Their Sapiential Background Michał Filip Powęska, 2024-12-09 When focusing on the sapiential traits in the text of the Fourth Gospel, it should be noted that in its images of wine, water, and bread, connected by the common theme of eating and drinking, one can see Jesus the Giver who, like the Old Testament personified wisdom, bestows his gifts on man. Although single references to the Old Testament sapiential texts have been suggested for the Johannine images of wine, water, bread, light, and the vine, no detailed study of these images as well as their juxtapositions, even in the aspect of eating and drinking, has been published so far. The conference successfully connected the older with the younger generation and thus contributed to maintaining and renewing the interest in ancient Salamis. It might be regarded as a tribute to Salamis, an outstanding ancient city which existed for more than one and a half millennia, eventually under the name of Constantia.
