

Questions on The Great Gatsby chapter 7 ANSWER KEY

Notes for the instructor: Again, I would suggest starting off class with any one of the bellringer prompts. If students are listening to you read out loud to them, they'll likely need some time at the end of class to answer the questions. Once they are working on the questions, you should circulate around the room, making sure that they can find the appropriate passages.

1. What has changed about Gatsby's house?

He has stopped throwing parties, has fired all of his usual servants, and he has hired some associates of ~~Wolfsheimer's~~ because he wants more discretion as Daisy is coming to his house frequently.

2. What is the weather like in this chapter? What effect would this have on people?

It's very hot. Other people get irritated or used to the heat.

3. How does the description of Jordan and Daisy on the couch relate to the first time that Nick met them in chapter one? (What other parallels or similarities can you find between this chapter and the first?)

They are sitting on the couch in the same room as they were in the first chapter, but this time they are described as weighed down while in the first chapter they looked as if they had just come back in the ground after flying around the room. Some other parallels are that Tom's "summer" villa, that they are eating at the Buchanan's house, and that Daisy and Tom's daughter is in this scene, also, while Tom brought up his pseudoscientific beliefs on race in chapter one, here he talks about pseudoscientific beliefs about the sun and the earth, finally, while the first chapter took place right before the beginning of summer, this chapter takes place right before the beginning of fall.

4. How does Tom react when he realizes that Daisy loves Gatsby?

Nick describes Tom's reaction: "He was astounded. His mouth opened a little, and he looked at Gatsby, and then back at Daisy as if he had just recognized her as someone he knew a long time ago." In these words, he is shocked that Daisy would love someone like Gatsby, and she now looks different to his eyes.

5. What does Nick realize about Daisy's voice?

Gatsby says, "Her voice is full of money" and Nick adds to that description by saying "It was full of money — that was the inescapable charm that drew and held us in it, the magic of it, the symbolic song of it. . . . high in a white palace the king's daughter, the golden girl. . . ." By comparing it to money, Nick and Gatsby emphasize the inescapability and the pull of her voice as well as the magic and mystery that Nick has been noticing in her voice since the beginning of the book.
