Plato's Democratic Entanglements S. Sara Monoson, 2013-08-18 In this book Sara Monoson challenges the longstanding and widely held view that Plato is a virulent opponent of all things democratic She does not however offer in its place the equally mistaken idea that he is somehow a partisan of democracy Instead she argues that we should attend more closely to Plato's suggestion that democracy is horrifying and exciting and she seeks to explain why he found it morally and politically intriguing Monoson focuses on Plato's engagement with democracy as he knew it a cluster of cultural practices that reach into private and public life as well as a set of governing institutions She proposes that while Plato charts tensions between the claims of democratic legitimacy and philosophical truth he also exhibits a striking attraction to four practices central to Athenian democratic politics intense antityranny frank speaking public funeral oratory and theater going By juxtaposing detailed examination of these aspects of Athenian democracy with analysis of the figurative language dramatic structure and arguments of the dialogues she shows that Plato systematically links democratic ideals and activities to philosophic labor Monoson finds that Plato's political thought exposes intimate connections between Athenian democratic politics and the practice of philosophy Situating Plato's political thought in the context of the Athenian democratic imaginary Monoson develops a new textured way of thinking of the relationship between Plato's thought and the politics of his city

The Archaeology of Ancient Greece James Whitley,2001-10-04 A synthesis of research on the material culture of Greece in the Archaic and Classical periods **The Parthenon Enigma** Joan Breton Connelly,2014-01-28 Built in the fifth century b c the Parthenon has been venerated for more than two millennia as the West s ultimate paragon of beauty and proportion Since the Enlightenment it has also come to represent our political ideals the lavish temple to the goddess Athena serving as the model for our most hallowed civic architecture But how much do the values of those who built the Parthenon truly correspond with our own And apart from the significance with which we have invested it what exactly did this marvel of human hands mean to those who made it In this revolutionary book Joan Breton Connelly challenges our most basic assumptions about the Parthenon and the ancient Athenians Beginning with the natural environment and its rich mythic associations she re creates the development of the Acropolis the Sacred Rock at the heart of the city state from its prehistoric origins to its Periklean glory days as a constellation of temples among which the Parthenon stood supreme In particular she probes the Parthenon s legendary frieze the 525 foot long relief sculpture that originally encircled the upper reaches before it was partially destroyed by Venetian cannon fire in the seventeenth century and most of what remained was shipped off to Britain in the nineteenth century among the Elgin marbles The frieze s vast enigmatic procession a dazzling pageant of cavalymen and elders musicians and maidens has for more than two hundred years been thought to represent a scene of annual civic celebration in the birthplace of democracy But thanks to a once lost play by Euripides the discovery of which in the wrappings of a Hellenistic Egyptian mummy is only one of this book s intriguing adventures Connelly has uncovered a long buried meaning a story of human sacrifice set during the city s mythic founding In a society startlingly preoccupied with cult ritual this story was at the core of what it meant to be Athenian Connelly reveals a world that beggars our popular notions of Athens as a city of staid philosophers rationalists and rhetoricians a world in which our modern secular conception of democracy would have been simply incomprehensible The Parthenon s full significance has been obscured until now owing in no small part Connelly argues to the frieze s dismemberment And so her investigation concludes with a call to reunite the pieces in order that what is perhaps the greatest single work of art surviving from antiquity may be viewed more nearly as its makers intended Marshalling a breathtaking range of textual and visual evidence full of fresh insights woven into a thrilling

narrative that brings the distant past to life The Parthenon Enigma is sure to become a landmark in our understanding of the civilization from which we claim cultural descent
