Mitra, Ramya Sundaram, 2009-02-19 The past two decades in Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union have been times of tremendous change with countries undergoing rapid transformation from centrally planned to market oriented economies While poverty increased during the initial years of transition primarily on account of the sharp economic contraction the resurgence of economic growth in the region since 1998 has resulted in a rebound in household incomes and living standards Data from the 2006 Life in Transition Survey LiTS a joint initiative of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the World Bank provides a unique opportunity to investigate the extent to which citizens of ECA countries are satisfied with their lives and with the performances of their governments and to study key factors influencing their outlook in a systematic way across all countries of the region The main objective of the LiTS was to assess the impact of transition on people covering four main themes First it collected personal information on aspects of material well being including household expenditures possession of consumer goods such as a car or mobile phone and access to local public services and utilities Second the survey included measures of satisfaction and attitudes towards economic and political reforms as well as public service delivery Third the LiTS captured individual histories key events and episodes that may have influenced their attitudes towards reforms and information on family background employment and coping strategies Finally the survey also attempted to capture the extent to which crime and corruption are affecting peoples lives and the extent to which individuals trust in other people and in state institutions has changed over time Dietary change and food demand in urbanizing Bangladesh Ecker, Olivier, Comstock, Andrew R., 2021-12-31 Poor quality diets are one of the leading causes of malnutrition and common non communicable disease In this study we use nationally representative household survey data and food demand system estimations to analyze dietary change and changing consumer preferences

for different foods in the context of urbanization in low and middle income countries We estimate and compare income and price elasticities of total food demand and the demand for 15 food groups in rural urban and city areas of Bangladesh for 2010 and 2016 We then use Oaxaca Blinder decomposition regressions to explore how much of the observed food consumption changes can be explained by changes in revealed consumer preferences vis vis changes in household income and food prices The results show that Bangladeshi diets shifted from coarse to refined rice and consumer preferences for vegetables and pulses were relatively low contributing to worsening dietary quality. Pereira da Silva, 2003 Development is about fundamental change in economic structures about the movement of resources out of agriculture to services and industry about migration to cities and international movement of labor and about transformation in trade and technology Social inclusion and change change in health and life expectancy in education and literacy in population size and structure and in gender relations are at the heart of the story The policy challenge is to help release and guide these forces of change and inclusion But how can policymakers assess whether what they have done or what they are doing is right Since the 1970s public economics has placed the serious analysis of growth at the center of its agenda It has shown how to integrate growth and distribution in simple terms the size of the cake and the distribution of the cake rigorously into the discussion of public policy both theoretically and empirically Welfare and vulnerability in Tajikistan: Evidence from twelve districts in Khatlon Province, 2015 - 2023 Lambrecht, Isabel, Mardonova, Mohru, Akramov, Kamiljon T., 2023-09-29 In February March 2023 2 000 households were interviewed about their socio economic conditions in twelve districts of Khatlon Province which constitute USAID's Zone of Influence ZOI Based on these recent survey data as well as former survey data from 2015 and 2012 we present findings here related to changes in poverty over the past eight to ten years Key findings Housing conditions improved indicating improved living conditions Only 1 percent of households had improved sanitation in 2015 but nearly half 49 percent of all households did so in 2023 Fewer households experience hunger in 2023 than in 2015 Fewer households reported having had no food in the home at least once in the past month 40 percent in 2015 vs 27 percent in 2023 and household hunger scores declined from 0 667 in 2015 to 0 523 in 2023 Expenditures on food increased but these were used to purchase more expensive food rather than improving dietary quality Consumption patterns mainly shifted towards more expensive sources of protein i e the consumption of meat chicken and fish Consumption of other food groups however reduced This led to a stagnation in diet diversity among women of which 30 percent have inadequate dietary diversity Women have significantly worse dietary quality than men but household consumption patterns do show improvements over time Total consumption expenditures increased nearly ten percent in real terms between 2015 and 2023 which is also accompanied by a significant drop in poverty over that period from 39 1 per cent to 28 7 percent Movements of households in and out of poverty and fluctuations in household food security status between 2015 and 2023 suggest that a significant share of households are at risk of falling back into poverty in the face of adversity Correlates with consumption expenditures poverty and the prosperity gap demonstrate that households with more household members with fewer livelihood sources and in more remote locations are worse off Households with more women are more likely to be poor given women s limited income generating opportunities Households that participated in agriculture development activities were approximately 12.7 per cent more likely to move out of poverty than other households Poverty measurement by phone: Developing and

testing alternative poverty metrics from the nationally representative Myanmar Household Welfare Survey (MHWS), Round 1 (December 2021-January 2022) Myanmar Agriculture Policy Support Activity (MAPSA), 2022-06-28 Poverty measurement in low and middle income countries LMICs has always been challenging especially among rural households whose incomes are characterized by seasonality informality and some degree of subsistence consumption During the COVID 19 pandemic poverty measurement became even more challenging as research had to resort phone surveys who necessary brevity precludes the use of detailed household expenditure modules preferred in rural settings Phone surveys instead typically resorted to qualitative questions on income losses and other welfare impacts of economic shocks Here we use the new nationally representative Myanmar Household Welfare Survey MHWS to experiment with three kinds of poverty measures 1 Asset poverty 10 questions 2 Income poverty a maximum of 17 questions and 3 Food expenditure poverty based on 4 questions We first describe the methods for constructing these three indicators including the poverty lines used for income and food poverty and their conceptual strengths and weaknesses before turning to a descriptive analysis of their geographical patterns their associations with each other and with expenditure based poverty in the last national survey in 2017 We then test their ability to predict poor diet quality and experiences of hunger which based on previous studies are outcomes that ought to be highly sensitive to household poverty. We draw three important conclusions for measuring poverty in phone surveys First asset poverty and income poverty are strongly associated with each other and with state region poverty patterns of expenditure based poverty in 2017 Second asset poverty was consistently the strongest predictor of poor diet diversity among adults and children as well as food insecurity at the household level but income poverty also predicted these outcomes even after controlling for asset poverty Third we argue that phone surveys should measure both asset and income poverty but should likely steer clear of food expenditure measures which will either require overly long survey instruments or very short questionnaires susceptible to underestimate of expenditure and overestimation of poverty However asset and income poverty are relatively guick and easy to measure and conceptual complements to each other income poverty is likely to be sensitive to shocks and seasonality while asset poverty is insensitive to these fluctuations but captures long term wealth Finally another important benefit of measuring income poverty is its ability to capture the effects of inflationary shocks as inflation can affect both nominal incomes e g through unemployment as well as through the analyst s price adjustments to the real food poverty line Improving our knowledge on small-scale fisheries: data needs and methodologies Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, 2017-01-01 Small scale fisheries play an important role in contributing to food security nutrition livelihoods and local and national economies However there is often limited data and information available or not easily accessible on their contributions and hence small scale fisheries tend to be overlooked and marginalized in policy processes leading to low levels of support for the sector The Voluntary Guidelines for Securing Sustainable Small Scale Fisheries in the Context of Food Security and P overty Eradication the SSF Guidelines
