specific ends Such an analysis requires that neither the individual bombers nor their sponsoring organizations be the basic unit of discussion Instead the bombers must be understood as components within a much larger system that has been shaped by a host of social cultural and operational constraints throughout its existence Integrating insights from the historical analysis of other technological systems with the recent literature specifically devoted to suicide bombing therefore allows The Business of Martyrdom to develop a fuller understanding of suicide bombing as a unified yet diverse phenomenon
