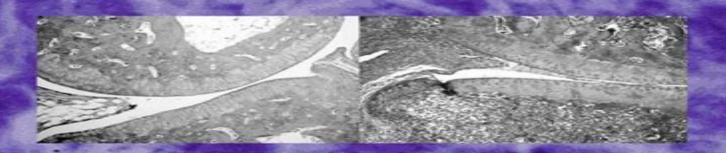

This development has given rise to the concept of conformational diseases and the broader signature of protein folding diseases comprising diseases in which mutations or environmental stresses may result in a partial misfolding that leads then to alternative conformations capable of disturbing cellular processes This may happen by self association aggregation as in prion and Alzheimer's diseases or by incorporation of alternatively folded subunits into structural entities as in collagen diseases Another possibility is that folding to the native structure is impaired or abolished resulting in decreased stea state levels of the correctly folded protein as is observed in cystic fibrosis and 1 antitrypsin deficiency as well as in many enzyme deficiencies. In addition deficiencies of proteins that are engaged in assisting and supervising protein folding protein quality control may impair the folding of many other proteins resulting in pathological phenotypes Examples of this are the spastic paraplegia attributable to mutations in mitochondrial protease chaperone complexes **Directed Enzyme Evolution** Frances H.
