by improving efficiency For example improved revenue collection and utility management could generate US 3 3 billion per year Regional power trade could reduce annual costs by US 2 billion And deregulating the trucking industry could reduce freight costs by one half So raising more funds without also tackling inefficiencies would be like pouring water into a leaking bucket Finally the power sector and fragile states represent particular challenges Even if every efficiency in every infrastructure sector could be captured a substantial funding gap of 31 billion a year would remain Nevertheless the African people and economies cannot wait any longer Now is the time to begin the transformation to sustainable development
