Institutionalisering van criminologie

1938 rijksuniversiteit Gent → oprichting instituut criminologie = **prof Nico Gunzburg**.

- Naamsverandering = school voor criminologie (school >< unief) => vandaag vakgroep criminologie

11 nov 1918: interesse voor criminologie door WO 1 => W-VL slagveld

- Deelmobilisatie: veel soldaten blijven hangen aan de frontstreek => geen Belgen, fransen enz. Fransen hadden alle nationaliteiten in hun leger => zij bleven hangen. +> nieuwe mensen= nieuwe criminele activiteiten bv valsmunterij en handel in blanke slavinnen → nieuwe politie INTERPOL (info over alle landen hun criminaliteit bijhouden)

The Other Side of Criminology Gerardus Petrus Hoefnagels, 2013-06-29 Didactically a textbook of criminology should start at the beginning The learning process also an emotional process begins in criminology with the concepts views emotions attitudes and ideas we have regarding crime and criminals Exploration of these underlying factors is one of the aims of the present book We can free our thinking only by being aware of the significance of our own feelings and thoughts about a phenomenon like crime That is the basic problem confronting us In scientific thinking implicit postulates as to the *sensus communis* unless recognized and 1 neutralized grow into idols The fight against crime is one example of such an idol

Crimes and criminals exist only by virtue of reactions to certain forms of behavior For this reason this book will begin by examining the reactions of society to crime Criminology is primarily a science of others than offenders In this sense I invert criminology The history of criminology is not so much a history of offenders² as a history of the reactions of those in power

Tegenwoordig staat Nederland bekend als een van de minst corrupte landen ter wereld De vestiging van vrije verkiezingen een moderne markteconomie een professionele bureaucratie en een democratische rechtsstaat ging echter gepaard met corruptieschandalen zo blijkt uit deze geschiedenis van corruptie en goed bestuur tussen 1848 en 1940 Dat de liberale minister van Financiën zijn voorstel voor een belastingverhoging voor Limburg introk om Limburgse kiezers te paaien leidde tot de Limburgse brievenaffaire 1865 Bij het Billiton-schandaal 1882-1892 floot het parlement de gouverneur van Indië terug omdat hij een onrechtmatige en schadelijke concessie aan een onderneming had verleend Het ingrijpen van de katholieke minister van Justitie in een strafrechtelijk onderzoek naar misstanden in het katholieke Oss leidde tot de zaak Oss 1938-39 Wat opvalt is dat in Nederland corruptieschandalen als morele in plaats van strafrechtelijke kwesties werden behandeld Daarmee ontstond een bestuurlijke traditie die tot op heden merkbaar is

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
