Wind

What is wind?

Wind is the movement of air from one place to another. It is caused by differences in air pressure. Wind can be felt as a breeze or a strong gust. Wind can also move objects like leaves, papers, and small toys.

How is wind measured?

Wind is measured using a windmill. The windmill has a cup that catches the wind. The cup is connected to a series of gears that turn a needle on a dial. The needle shows the speed of the wind in kilometers per hour (km/h).

What is a windmill?

A windmill is a machine that converts the energy of the wind into mechanical or electrical energy. It is used to generate power, pump water, and grind grain.
