Arab Turkish Russian and other neighbors are discussed focusing on both the direct and indirect impact of the nuclear agreement on these relations especially the paradoxical implications of the nuclear deal with respect to the non nuclear crises in the Middle East such as the Syria Iraq crisis and the re alignments that have put Iran at the crossroads of East and West Other issues covered include energy security regional economic cooperation the endemic sectarianism highlighted by Iran Saudi competition and the deadlock on the Middle East peace process The third section then examines the issue of a Middle East nuclear weapons free zone and the likely consequences of the Iran nuclear deal on this prospect which in turn raises the issue of regional proliferation and counterproliferation The last section explores some possible various scenarios and the challenges of implementation as a relatively long term agreement providing specific policy recommendations for the regional actors and the external powers that are stakeholders in the volatile Middle East
