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Madame de Treymes and Three Novellas Edith Wharton, 1995-12-18 Madame de Treymes Edith Wharton's first publication after the highly successful *The House of Mirth* is a captivating portrait of turn of the century American and French culture Inspired by Wharton's own entry into Parisian society in 1906 and reminiscent of the works of Henry James it tells the story of two young innocents abroad Fanny Frisbee of New York unhappily married to the dissolute Marquis de Malrive and John Durham her childhood friend who arrives in Paris intent on convincing Fanny to divorce her husband and marry him instead A subtle investigation of the clash of cultures and the role of women in the social hierarchy Madame de Treymes confirms Edith Wharton's position as Edmund Wilson wrote as an historian of the American society of her time This Scribner edition of Madame de Treymes also includes three novellas *The Touchstone Sanctuary* and *Bunner Sisters* These short works are rich in the social satire and cunning insight that characterized Wharton's highly acclaimed novels *The Age of Innocence* and *The House of Mirth*

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Pastoral Cosmopolitanism in Edith Wharton's Fiction Margarida Cadima, 2023-07-11 American novelist Edith Wharton 1862-1937 is best known today for her tales of the city and the experiences of patrician New Yorkers in the Gilded Age This book pushes against the grain of critical orthodoxy by prioritizing other species of spaces in Wharton's work For example how do Wharton's narratives represent the organic profusion of external nature Does the current scholarly fascination with the environmental humanities reveal previously unexamined or overlooked facets of Wharton's craft I propose that what is most striking about her narrative practice is how she utilizes adapts and translates pastoral tropes conventions and concerns to twentieth century American actualities It is no accident that Wharton portrays characters returning to or exploring various natural localities such as private gardens public parks chic mountain resorts monumental ruins or country estate follies Such encounters and adventures prompt us to imagine new relationships with various geographies and the lifeforms that can be found there The book addresses a knowledge gap in Wharton and the environmental humanities especially recent debates in ecocriticism The excavation of Wharton's words and the background of her narratives with an eye to offering an ecocritical reading of her work is what the book focuses on

Interspersed with witty evocative sketches of country life among the English nobility is the well-known tale *The Stout Gentleman* and stories based on English, French, and Spanish folklore vividly recounted with Irving's inimitable blend of elegance and colloquial dash. *Tales of a Traveller* (1824), written after a year-long stay in Germany, is a pivotal work in Irving's career, marking his last experiment with fiction before he turned to the writing of history, biography, and adaptation of folktales. Irving felt his new stories to be some of the best things I have ever written. They may not be as highly finished as some of my former writings, but they are touched off with a freer spirit and are more true to life. *The Alhambra* (1832) was inspired by Irving's stay during the spring and summer of 1829 at the ancient Moorish palace in Granada, which he called one of the most remarkable romantic and delicious spots in the world. This rich compendium of tales deftly interwoven with historical accounts and picturesque sketches was assembled from Spanish and Moorish folklore, history, guidebooks, and anecdotes of Irving's experiences among the local residents.
