Thomas Arthur Leonard and the Co-operative Holidays Association Douglas George Hope, 2016-12-14 This book focuses on Thomas Arthur Leonard a Congregational minister in Colne Lancashire in the 1890s and the Co operative Holidays Association which he founded in 1893 The Co operative Holidays Association which was re named the Countrywide Holidays Association in 1964 but was always affectionately known as the CHA operated as an independent provider of outdoor holidays until 2002 Leonard left the CHA in 1913 to establish the Holiday Fellowship an organisation with similar ideals to the CHA which continues to trade as HF Holidays Leonard was also instrumental in the establishment of the Youth Hostels Association in 1930 and the formation of the Ramblers Association in 1935 of which he was the first President He strongly supported the National Trust founded in 1895 and was a stalwart of the campaign for national parks during the 1930s He was a founder member of the Friends of the Lake District in 1934 and was connected with a number of other outdoor holiday organisations This book details the life and achievements of this extraordinary man who rebelled against the conventionality of the 1880s and 1890s and was appalled by the dull and grim lives of artisans and textile workers in the industrial north of England It also tells the story of the CHA which pioneered walking holidays in the outdoors for working people from its foundation in 1893 to its demise in 2004 The book describes how the CHA faced the challenges of changing social economic and cultural conditions during the twentieth century such as increasing affluence and consumer choice changing cultural attitudes and expectations the popularisation of outdoor recreation and the proliferation of outdoor holiday providers It shows how the CHA drifted away from its original ideals in an attempt to remain viable in the face of increasing consumerism but nevertheless continued to provide holidays for thousands of people based on healthy recreation and quiet enjoyment and the principles of friendship and fellowship

The Collected Letters of A.W.N. Pugin Augustus Welby Northmore Pugin, 2001 The importance of A W N Pugin 1812-52 in architecture and design in England and beyond is incontestable The leading architect of the Gothic Revival Pugin is one of

the most significant figures of the mid nineteenth century and one of the greatest designers His correspondence furnishes more insight into the man and more information about his work than any other source This volume the last of five contains letters from 1851 and the first months of 1852 after that Pugin s health failed and he died in September In the great event of the period the international exhibition held in the Crystal Palace in Hyde Park the display of objects made to Pugin s design which he planned and oversaw was an outstanding success bringing substantial commercial benefit to his colleagues and spreading Pugin s influence even more widely than before The value of his judgment was recognized in his appointment to two committees in connection with the Great Exhibition Frantic though the preparations for what came to be known as the Medieval Court were Pugin made time to write for publication He issued letters and pamphlets in explanation defence and support of the Catholic Church and its re established hierarchy and turned again to the conundrum that had long teased him the relation between the faith and the form not only architectural in which it found expression He completed the book on chancel screens conceived some years before At home in The Grange at Ramsgate he continued to design stained glass windows for other architects as well as his own clients and supervised the production of cartoons he poured out designs in his usual fields of metalwork ceramics furniture carving and wallpaper and branched out not always happily into new areas such as embroidery and the decoration of piano cases The demand for drawings for Westminster where the House of Commons was due to open early in 1852 was as incessant as ever His last child Edmund Peter was born in 1851 only a few months before his first grandchild Mildred Both were baptized in the church of St Augustine which he was still building next to his house and where he himself was soon to be laid in the vault he provided for the purpose The volume also includes some letters which have come to light too late for inclusion in their proper chronological places and some texts of doubtful authenticity *Palmer's index to the Times newspaper* ,1918 *Real Fantasies* Patricia Johnston,2023-11-15 During the 1920s and 1930s Edward Steichen was the most successful photographer in the advertising industry Although much has been said about Steichen s fine art photography his commercial work which appeared regularly in Vanity Fair Vogue Ladies Home Journal and almost every other popular magazine published in the United States has not received the attention it deserves At a time when photography was just beginning to replace drawings as the favored medium for advertising Steichen helped transform the producers of such products as Welch s grape juice and Jergens lotion from small family businesses to national household names In this book Patricia Johnston uses Steichen s work as a case study of the history of advertising and the American economy between the wars She traces the development of Steichen s work from an early naturalistic style through increasingly calculated attempts to construct consumer fantasies By the 1930s alluring images of romance and class developed in collaboration with agency staff and packaged in overtly manipulative and persuasive photographs became Steichen s stock in trade He was most frequently chosen by agencies for products targeted toward women his images depicted vivacious singles earnest new mothers and other stereotypically female life stages that reveal a great deal about the
