This work explores how it is among other things that deliberative institutions can become more democratic through as Dewey put it, improvements in the methods and conditions of debate, discussion and persuasion.

Christianity, Democracy, and the Radical Ordinary Stanley Hauerwas, Romand Coles, 2008-01-01 In *Christianity, Democracy, and the Radical Ordinary*, theologian Stanley Hauerwas and political theorist Romand Coles reflect about possibilities and practices of radical democracy and radical ecclesia that take form in the textures of relational care for the radical ordinary. They seek to shift political and theological imaginations beyond the limits of contemporary political formations such as global capitalism, the mega-state and empire which they argue are based upon both the denial and production of death. Hauerwas and Coles call us to a revolutionary politics of wild patience that seeks transformation through attentive practices of listening, relationship building and a careful tending to places, common goods and diverse possibilities for flourishing. Both authors translate back and forth across as well as dwell in the tensions between the languages of radical democracy and of trial, cross and resurrection. Engaging each other through a variety of genres from essays to letters to co-writing and dialogue, Hauerwas and Coles seek to enact a politics that is evangelical in its radical receptivity across strange differences and that cultivates power in relation to vulnerability. The authors argue that there is a strong relation between hope and imagination as well as between imagination and the encounter with and memory of those who have lived with receptive generosity toward the radical ordinary. Hence throughout this book they think extensively in relation to specific lives and practices from Ella Baker and the early Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee organizing efforts for beloved community and civil rights to L'Arche communities founded by Jean Vanier to contemporary faith-based radical democratic organizing efforts in dozens of cities by the Industrial Areas Foundation. Pushing and pulling each other into new and insightful journeys of political

imagination this conversation between a radical Christian and a radical democratic trickster spurs us toward a politics that acknowledges tends to and enacts the powers of the radical ordinary      **Composition and Cornel West** Keith

Phillip Luke Sinitiere, 2023-06-23 Contributions by Murali Balaji Charisse Burden Stelly Christopher Cameron Carlton Dwayne Floyd Robert Greene II Andre E Johnson Werner Lange Lisa J McLeod Jodi Melamed Tyler Monson Eric Porter Reiland Rabaka Thomas Ehrlich Reifer Camesha Scruggs and Phillip Luke Sinitiere Although the career of W E B Du Bois was remarkable in its entirety a large majority of scholarship focuses on the first five or six decades Overlooked and understudied the closing three decades of Du Bois s career reflect a generative period of his life in terms of teaching travel activism and publications Forging Freedom in W E B Du Bois s Twilight Years No Deed but Memory proposes to narrate the political social and cultural significance of Du Bois s career during the controversial closing three decades of his life Du Bois s twilight years were tremendously controversial his persistent criticism of the collusion between capitalism and racism and his choice to join the Communist Party in late 1961 raised the ire of many At the time Du Bois s strident advocacy of socialism and turn to communism during the Cold War oriented most scholars away from delving into his late career While only a few scholars have engaged the productivity of Du Bois s later years the fact is that an anticommunist antiradical animus has followed Du Bois in the half century since his death As a result Du Bois scholarship remains impoverished to the extent that academics neglect his later years The essays in Forging Freedom in W E B Du Bois s Twilight Years detail selected aspects of Du Bois s later decades and their particular connection to American social political and cultural history between the 1930s and the 1960s While international concerns and a global perspective also fundamentally defined Du Bois s latter years chronicling his final decades in a US context presents fresh insight into his twilight years Du Bois s commitment to freedom s flourishing during this period animated the Black freedom struggle s war against white supremacy Ultimately this book demonstrates that the durability of Du Bois s intellectual achievements remains relevant to the twenty first century

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
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
