Davis, 1995 Davis has chosen five biblical preachers within the Anglican tradition and addresses the so called crisis in contemporary preaching its impoverished understanding of the meaning and uses of scripture This will be of special interest to seminarians and clergy in the Anglican tradition **Imaginative Preaching** Geoff New, 2015-10-14 From generation to generation there has been an anguished cry from preachers about preaching there is no imagination The Scriptures present the wondrous hope and vision of Kingdom Come and yet contemporary preaching can often be mute and blind by comparison This book explores what is possible when the Scripture to be preached is prayed through the agency of two ancient prayer disciplines lectio divina and Ignatian Gospel Contemplation Through the experiences of eight vocational pastor preachers this study tracks the difficulties discoveries and delights as they commit to utilizing these prayer disciplines as part of their regular sermon preparation The reader will be orientated to what a biblical imagination entails and how praying the Scriptures affects the preacher sermon and listener Careful explanation of how to pray using lectio divina and Ignatian Gospel Contemplation is included This work is in places a raw examination of the forces that regularly conspire against the preacher as they endeavour to faithfully expound the Scriptures The study is a rousing exclamation of the joy experienced when a preacher's imagination and their preparation is formed by the Spirit bringing the Scriptures to bear on all who speak and hear it **Preaching from the Old Testament** Walter Brueggemann, 2019-05-07 In this new volume prolific scholar Walter Brueggemann seeks to show Christian preachers how to consider the faith witnessed in several Old Testament traditions and to help them discover rich and suggestive connections to our contemporary faith challenges The author also assumes that a wholesale sustained engagement with the Old Testament is worth the effort for the preacher He recognizes what he calls the sorry state of Old Testament texts in the Revised Common Lectionary which he claims often constitute a major disservice for the church and its preachers The lectionary gerrymanders the Old Testament to make it serve other claims most of the time not allowing it to have its own evangelical say Brueggemann hopes that his exposition in this volume will evoke and energize fresh homiletical attention to the Old Testament precisely because he believes the urgent work of the gospel in our society requires attentive listening to these ancient voices of bold insistent faith **The Role of Old Testament Theology in Old Testament Interpretation** Walter Brueggemann, 2015-05-14 This collection of essays is drawn from a series of previous collections to which the author has contributed that were designed to honor senior scholars in the discipline of Old Testament study Each of these essays reflects a distinct intention depending on the nature of the original collection in which they appeared and the scholar who was being honored Taken together however this collection amounts to an articulation of Brueggemann's distinctive approach to theological interpretation of the Old Testament Already in his major volume on Old Testament theology Brueggemann proposed a dynamism of tension dispute and contradiction as the text of ancient Israel sought to give voice to the mystery of
