

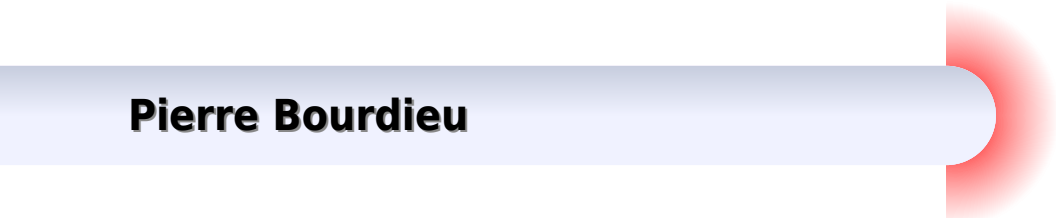

what it means to be Christian in relation to the Roman social order His conclusions have implications not only for the study of late antiquity but also for understanding the rhetorics of religious alienation more broadly both in the ancient world and today
