
Next, you count out your bands and put them in the squares on the Band Organizer. In this example there are 8 red "A" bands, 6 orange "B" bands, 6 yellow "C" bands, 6 green "D" bands, 6 blue "E" bands, and 6 purple "F" bands. These are the bands you will use to make your design.

If you should need to turn the page while you are making your design, you can transfer your bands from the Color Code Squares on the design page to the six Color Code Squares on the Band Organizer. It is a good idea to keep the color code bands on the design page whenever possible.

Once you have counted out your bands you are ready to start placing them on the loom.
