that the transformation in poetry music and painting the so called sister arts is the result of the abandonment of a natural aesthetic based on a set of rules shared between artist and audience and that this is virtually the same cognitive shift that occurred when scientists abandoned the mechanical philosophy of the Galilean revolution The cultural explanations for Modernism may still be relevant but they are epiphenomenal rather than causal Artists felt that traditional forms of art had been exhausted and they began to resort to private formats Easter eggs with hidden and often inaccessible meaning Keyser proposes that when artists discarded their natural rule governed aesthetic it marked a cognitive shift general intelligence took over from hardwired proclivity Artists used a different part of the brain to create and audiences were forced to play catch up

Art's Visionary Moment Sidney Homan, 2025-02-04 The collection Art's Visionary Moment Personal Encounters with Works That Last a Lifetime was inspired by T S Eliot's observation in his Dante 1929 The experience of a poem is the experience both of a moment and of a lifetime There is a first or an early moment which is unique which can never be forgotten but is never repeated integrally and yet which would become destitute of significance if it did not survive in a larger whole of experience In this collection scholars and artists from a variety of fields speak in personal terms but with what one has called intellectual passion of a work of art poem play novel film visual art among others that as Dante suggest has had an immediate effect on them the Visionary Moment from the title yet survives in a larger whole of experience that Last a Lifetime in the collection's sub title Some of the titles of essays already submitted show the range of this inquiry Conversations with the Dead Playing Richard III The Experience of a Moment and a Lifetime Picasso's Three Musicians Poetry Meets Power Tamburlaine the Great Pleasant Dreaming with Thanatopsis From Madness to Miracle An Encounter with Shakespeare's Winter's Tale Fight the Power Spike Lee's Visionary Moment and Plastic Art Moment *Glancing Visions* Zachary Tavlin, 2023-06-13 The sweeping vantages that typify American landscape painting from the nineteenth century by Thomas Cole and other members of the Hudson School are often interpreted for their geopolitical connotations as visual attempts to tame the wild alleviating fears of a savage frontier through views that subdue the landscape to the eye Zachary Tavlin's *Glancing Visions* challenges the long standing assumption that visuality in nineteenth century art and literature was inherently imperialistic or possessive While there is much to be said for both material economic and theological impulses to clear the wilderness superimpose a national identity and usher in a Puritanical idyll many literary figures of the era display a purposeful disdain for the possessive gaze signaling instead a preference for subtle glances often informed by early photography Impressionism new techniques in portraiture and soon after the dawn of cinema The visual subjectivities and contingencies introduced by these media made room for a visual counter narrative one informed by a mode of seeing that moves fast and lightly across the surface of things Tavlin probes Nathaniel Hawthorne's idea of the imagination one that derives from both the camera obscura in *The Custom House* and the daguerreotype in *The House of the Seven Gables* each in its way an instance of the glance and entirely dependent on temporal moments The poetry of Frances

Ellen Watkins Harper toggles between gazes and glances unsettling two competing forms of racialized seeing as they pertain to nineteenth century Black life and racial hierarchies the sentimental gaze and the slave trader's glance highlighting the life and death stakes of both looking anyone squarely in the eye and looking away Emily Dickinson's certain slant of light syntactical oddities and her stitching of scraps and fragments into the fascicles that constitute her corpus all derive from a commitment to contingency the ungrounded life's only defense against the abyss of non-being Tavlin investigates as well Henry James's vexed but entirely dependent relationship to literary and painterly impressionism and William Carlos Williams's imagist poetics as a response to early cinema's use of the cut as the basis for a new visual grammar Each of these literary artists Tavlin argues via their own distinctive sensibilities and the artistic or technological counterparts that informed them refuse the authoritative all possessive gaze in favor of the glance a mode of seeing thinking and being that made way for what we now think of as commonplace namely modernity

Walking Wounded Andrew Taylor, 2013-10-24 This uncompromising biography tells the story of a wounded D Day veteran a deserter a violent drunk a loving father who abandoned his first child a boxer and brawler a wife beater a bigamist and a passionately romantic lover It is also most importantly the story of a poet Vernon Scannell wrote some of the finest poetry to come out of the Second World War He won the Chomondeley Prize and the Heinemann Award and for half a century he was acknowledged as one of the leading poets in the country His Collected Poems are still in print and his poetry for both adults and children is regularly anthologised and appears on English Literature examination papers Scannell died in 2007 and Walking Wounded draws on his personal diaries poems and other writings to offer the first detailed study of this complex controversial and occasionally

tragic life For the first time the women who loved him tell their stories his children describe growing up with a father who was funny affectionate sometimes violent and often not there at all and his fellow poets including Seamus Heaney Anthony Thwaite Alan Brownjohn and Kit Wright speak of the dedicated stylist assured performer and occasionally roistering drunk that they knew Scannell was seriously wounded in Normandy shortly after D Day but the book looks at the deeper mental scars from the War that he bore all his life and of the suffering they caused to him and the people who loved him It is an important book about an important poet which investigates where poetry comes from and the terrible price that sometimes has to be paid for it
