This report is published, at the President's nomination, to keep members informed of the state-of-play with regard to the Institution's future relations with the Institution of Civil Engineers.

The relationship between this Institution and the Institution of Civil Engineers has been discussed several times in the last few years. Clifford Brown, when President, stated that he thought that structure for the building industry, and its associated technology, was the primary area of interest of our Institution and that the Institution of Civil Engineers should leave that body of knowledge to its. Alan Paterson, when President, suggested that we should consider a merger of our Institution with the Civic, though that did not receive Council or wider approval at that time.

The Civic suggested, in March 1986, that we should exchange membership between a new Group they were setting up to study building and our Science & Research Committee. We decided this and, at a subsequent meeting of the President and the two Senior Vice-Presidents of our Institution and the President, Alan Paterson (Vice-President), and Robin Wilson, a senior member, all of the Civic Council, we stated again that we thought these structural engineers interested in building belong in our Institution for both qualifications and expertise, since the Civic's Charter does not embrace them, and I quote:

"... the art of directing the great sources of power in Nature for the use and convenience of man, as the means of production and of wealth in states both for external and internal trade, as applied to the construction of roads, bridges, aqueducts, canals, river navigation and docks, the internal commerce and exchanges, and to the construction of ports, harbours, docks, breakwaters and light-houses, and to the art of navigation by artificial power for the purposes of commerce, and to the construction and adaptation of machinery, and to the drainage of cities and towns."

It was for this reason that our predecessors had been granted a Charter. We asked the Civic these questions, and they subsequently sent us the discussion paper that follows.

Introduction

(1) An Engineering Committee paper on the "Relationship between Civil Engineering and Building, including links with other bodies involved" was considered by Council at its meeting on 18 March 1986. The recommendations of that paper are set out in Appendix A. The Council took no decision on the paper pending wider consultation.

(2) This further paper has been prepared by a new Working Party, also set up by the Engineering Committee. It takes account of the discussion of Council, the views received from Local Associations and other Institutions. It also has regard to the Report of the Cross Working Relationships Working Party of the Institution of Mechanical Engineers which was published in August 1986.
