the new world of motion pictures where she not only revolutionized acting method but negotiated her own terms for the highest salary for any actress and complete creative control over her films unheard of behaviour for a woman of that period Pickford co founded United Artists in 1919 with Douglas Fairbanks and Charlie Chaplin which turned the existing studio system on its head The actress s subsequent marriage to Fairbanks incited a fan frenzy comparable to today s obsession with couples like Brad Pitt and Angelina Jolie Although Pickford's star faded with the advent of talking pictures she was the catalyst for the culture of Hollywood celebrity that enthralls us today William C. Van Horne Valerie Knowles, 2010-05-31 William C Van Horne was one of North America's most accomplished men Born in Illinois in 1843 Van Horne started working in the railway business at a young age In 1881 he was lured north to Canada to become general manager of the fledgling Canadian Pacific Ralway The railroading general pushed through construction of the CPR s transcontinental line and then went on to become the company's president During his time with the CPR Van Horne developed a telegraph service launched the Empress line of Pacific steamships in 1891 and founded CP Hotels He capped his career by opening up Cuba s interior with a railway A man of prodigious energy and many talents he also became Canada s foremost art collector and one of the country's leading financiers For all of his amazing accomplishments Van Horne was knighted in 1894 When he died church bells throughout the length and breadth of Cuba tolled to mark his passing and when his funeral train made its way across Canada all traffic on the CPR system was suspended for five minutes Peggy Dymond Leavey, 2012-05-12 2013 Speaker's Book Award Shortlisted Laura Secord is now famous for her singular feat of bravery during the War of 1812 but did she warn the British and help defeat the American invaders as her legend says After dragging her injured husband off the battlefield during the War of 1812 Laura Secord 1775 1868 was forced to house American soldiers for financial support while she nursed him back to health It was during this time that she overheard the American plan to ambush British troops at Beaver Dams Through an outstanding act of perseverance and courage in 1813 Laura walked an astonishing 30 kilometers from her home to a British outpost to warn Lieutenant James FitzGibbon Despite facing rough terrain the ever present danger of being caught by American troops and rather delicate encounters with Native forces Laura reached FitzGibbon just in time for the British to prepare and execute an ambush on American military nearby forcing the U S general to surrender Laura lived a very long time dying at the age of 93 In her lifetime the government never formally recognized her singular feat of bravery and much controversy still envelopes her legacy Henry Hudson Edward Butts, 2009-12-21 In 1607 Henry Hudson was an obscure English sea captain By 1610 he was an internationally renowned explorer He made two voyages in search of a Northeast Passage to the Orient and had discovered the Spitzbergen Islands and their valuable whaling grounds In the process Hudson had sailed farther north than any other European before him In 1609 working for the Dutch he had explored the Hudson River and had made a Dutch colony in America possible Sailing from England in 1610 on what would be his most famous voyage Hudson began his search for the Northwest Passage through the
