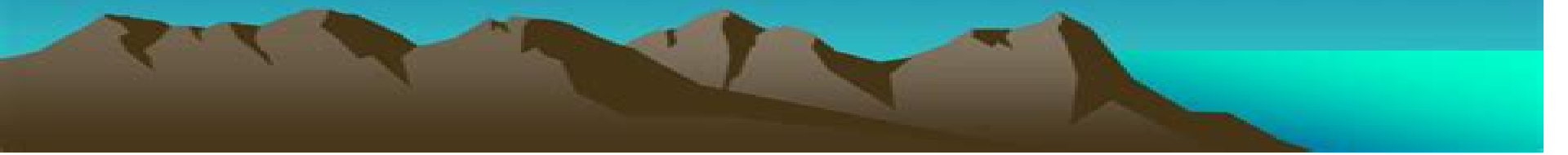


House-Tree-Person Test
