Part 1. Animal Diets

Background

Owls are raptors. Raptors are strictly meat eaters. They eat the whole animal (fur, bones, and flesh) to receive the nutrients they need. All raptors except owls can digest almost anything except the fur. Owls cannot digest the fur, teeth, and bones. Unlike other birds, owls have no crop. A crop is a loose sac in the throat that serves as storage for food for later consumption. The owl's stomach has two parts. The first part begins the process of digestion. The second part is the muscular stomach, or gizzard. There are no digestive glands in the gizzard. It holds back insoluble items such as bones, fur, teeth, and feathers. Several hours after eating, these items are compressed into a pellet that is the shape of the gizzard. It travels up to the first part of the stomach, and it may remain there up to 20 hours before being regurgitated. No other prey can be swallowed until the pellet is expelled. Regurgitation often signifies that an owl is ready to eat again.

By studying the bones found in owl pellets, scientists can find out about the diet of owls and the distribution of prey animals found in the area. Other ways scientists can study animal diets are by examining animal feces or "scat" or by dissecting the stomachs of dead animals to identify the contents of their last meal.

LABORATORY OBJECTIVES:

1. Separate the fur, bones, and teeth found in an owl pellet.
2. Clean and categorize the bones. Attempt to determine the number of mice and rats by pairing right and left lower jaw bones with the skull. Share information with the class to formulate ideas about the diets represented by these pellets.
