

The book concludes that establishing the right connections within such dense networks appears to be more crucial than any other factor thus highlighting the importance of linkages or the effects of their absence within innovation systems Proposing a taxonomy of knowledge sharing patterns this book will be warmly welcomed by academics researchers and postgraduate students in the areas of the economics of innovation evolutionary economics and knowledge economics **Memetics and Evolutionary Economics** Michael P.
