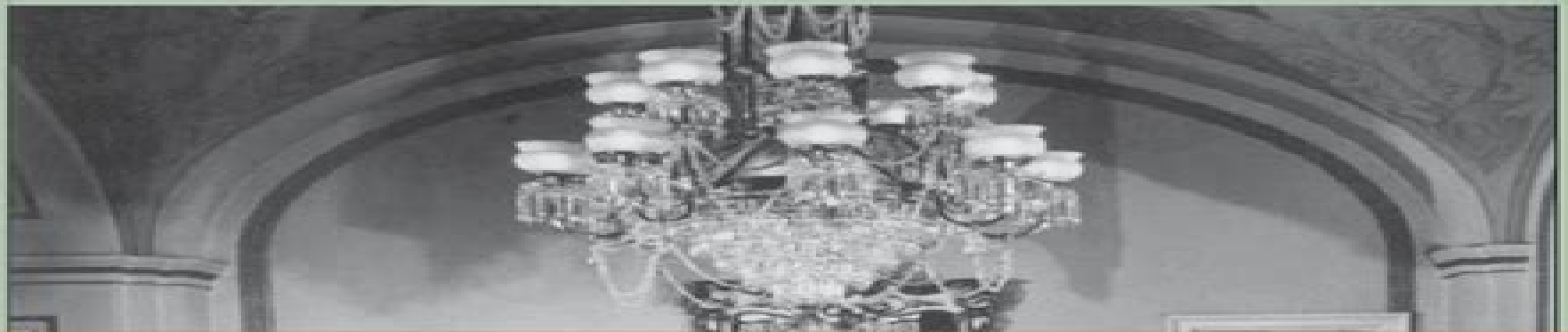

Polsby Heller Professor of Political Science University of California, 2003-11-14 From the end of the New Deal until quite recently the U S House of Representatives was dominated by a conservative coalition that thwarted the Democratic majority and prevented the enactment of measures proposed by a succession of liberal Presidents Today Presidents aren't necessarily liberal and the House of Representatives is not necessarily the graveyard of presidential proposals What happened Congress evolved It all began with airconditioning In this entertaining tale of one of our most august institutions Nelson Polsby describes how the Democratic majority finally succeeded in overcoming the conservative coalition changing the House The evolution required among other things the disappearance of Dixiecrats from the House Democratic caucus Dixiecrats were replaced by the rise of the Republican party in the south The Republican party in southern states was strengthened by an influx of migrants from the north who came south to settle after the introduction of residential air conditioning which made the climate more tolerable to Northerners This evolutionary process led to the House's liberalization and concluded with the House's later transformation into an arena of sharp partisanship visible among both Democrats and Republicans A fascinating read by one of our most influential political scientists How Congress Evolves breathes new life into the dusty corners of institutional history and offers a unique explanation for important transformations in the congressional environment

America's Three Regimes : A New Political History

Morton Keller Professor of History Brandeis University, 2007-09-26 When historians take the long view they look at ages or eras the Age of Jackson the Progressive Era But these time spans last no longer than a decade or so In this groundbreaking new book Morton Keller divides our nation's history into three regimes each of which lasts many many decades allowing us to appreciate as never before the slow steady evolution of American public life Americans like to think of our society as eternally young and effervescent But the reality is very different A proper history of America must be as much about continuity persistence and evolution as about transformation and revolution To provide this proper history Keller groups America's past into three long regimes Deferential and Republican from the colonial period to the 1820s Party and Democratic from the 1830s to the 1930s and Populist and Bureaucratic from the 1930s to the present This approach yields many new insights We discover for instance that the history of colonial America the Revolution and the Early Republic is a more unified story than usually assumed The Civil War industrialization and the Progressive era did relatively little to alter the character of the democratic party regime that lasted from the 1830s to the 1930s And the populist bureaucratic regime in which we live today has seen changes in politics government and law as profound as those that occurred in the late 18th and early 19th centuries As Keller underscores the sheer staying power of America's public institutions he sheds light on current concerns as well in particular will the current political polarization continue or will more moderate forces prevail Here then is a major contribution to United States history an entirely new way to look at our past our present and our future packed with provocative and original observations about American public life

Split Mark D. Brewer, Jeffrey M. Stonecash, 2007

Talk of politics in the United States today is abuzz with warring red and blue factions The message is that Americans are split due to deeply held beliefs over abortion gay marriage stem cell research prayer in public schools Is this cultural divide a myth the product of elite partisans Or is the split real Yes argue authors Mark Brewer and Jeffrey Stonecash the cultural divisions are real Yet they tell only half the story Differences in income and economic opportunity also fuel division a split along class lines Cultural issues have not displaced class issues as many believe Split shows that both divisions coexist meaning that levels of taxation and the quality of healthcare matter just as much as the debate over the right to life versus the right to choose The authors offer balanced objective analysis complete with a wealth of data rich figures and tables to explain the social trends underlying these class and cultural divides and then explore the response of the parties and voters Offering solid empirical evidence the authors show that how politicians the media and interest groups perceive citizen

preferences be they cultural or class based determines whether or not the public gets what it wants Simply put each set of issues creates political conflict and debate that produce very different policies and laws With a lively and highly readable narrative students at every level will appreciate the brevity and punch of Split and come away with a more nuanced understanding of the divisions that drive the current American polity Newt Gingrich Matthew N. Green,Jeffrey Crouch,2022-07-15 Newt Gingrich is one of the most polarizing and consequential figures in US politics First elected to the House of Representatives in 1978 he rose from a minority party backbencher to become the first Republican Speaker of the House in forty years Though much has been written about Gingrich accounts of his time in Congress are incomplete and often skewed In their book Newt Gingrich The Rise and Fall of a Party Entrepreneur political scientists Matthew N Green and Jeffrey Crouch draw from newly uncovered archival material original interviews and other data to provide a fresh and insightful look at Gingrich s entire congressional career Green and Crouch argue that Gingrich is best understood as a party entrepreneur someone who works primarily to achieve their congressional party s collective goals From the moment he entered Congress Gingrich was laser focused on achieving two party related objectives a Republican majority in the House and a more conservative society as well as greater influence for himself Using a conceptual framework taken from theories of military strategy the authors explain how Gingrich initially struggled because of a mismatch between his lofty goals and the resources available to him After years of patiently cultivating allies tempering his immediate objectives and waiting for favorable circumstances to emerge Gingrich finally claimed victory in 1994 with Republicans winning control of the House and electing Gingrich as Speaker Yet while Gingrich had been creative patient and ultimately successful at gaining power for himself and his party he proved ineffective at balancing his goals with the demands of the Speakership and he resigned from Congress just four years later Newt Gingrich The Rise and Fall of a Party Entrepreneur the latest contribution to the Congressional Leaders series sheds new light on a historically important congressional leader whose complicated legacy is still debated today by scholars journalists and politicians Institutions of American Democracy Paul J.
