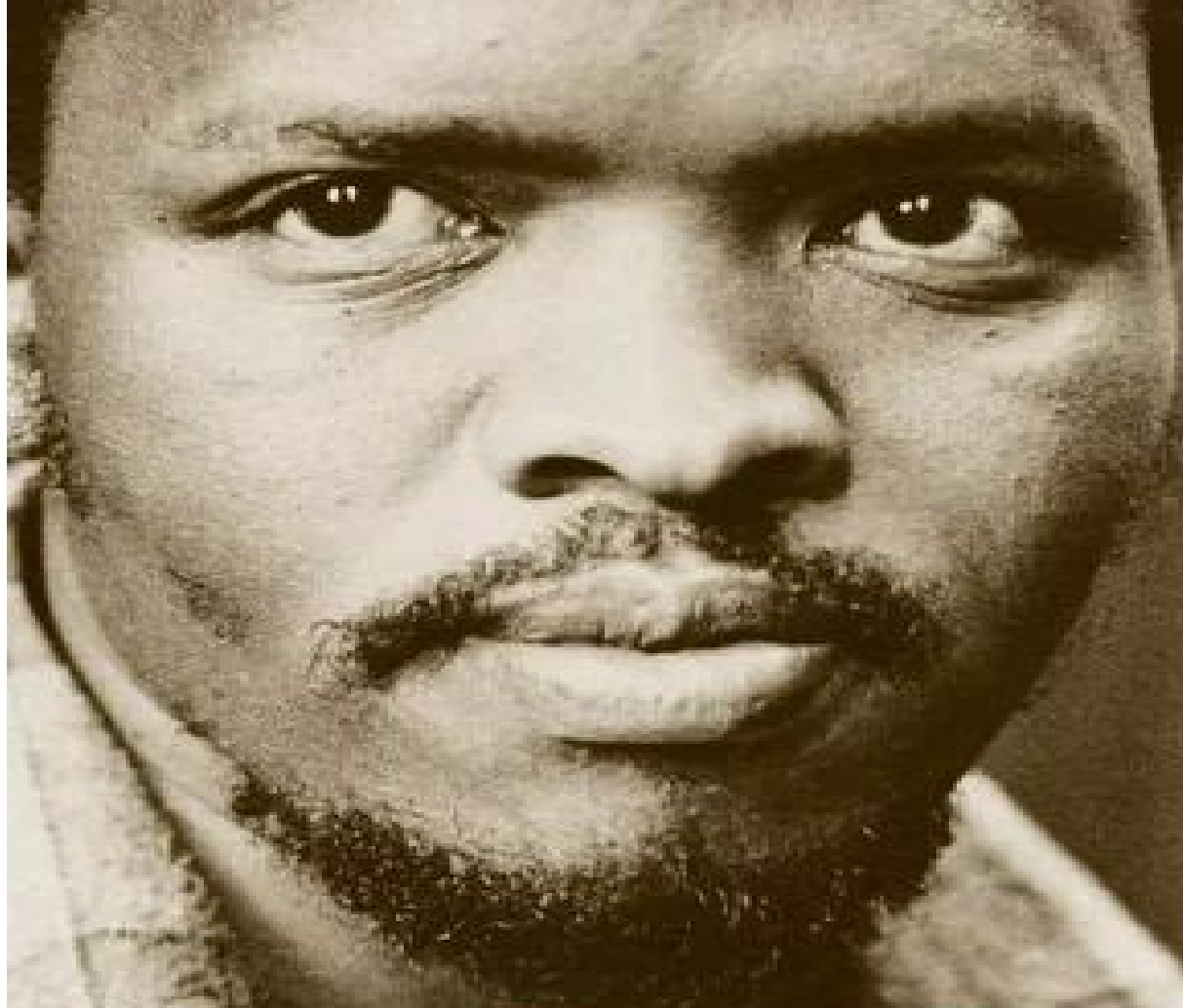

I Write What I Like Steve Biko, 2015-10-16 The most potent weapon in the hands of the oppressor is the mind of the oppressed Like all of Steve Biko's writings those words testify to the passion courage and keen insight that made him one of the most powerful figures in South Africa's struggle against apartheid They also reflect his conviction that black people in South Africa could not be liberated until they united to break their chains of servitude a key tenet of the Black Consciousness movement that he helped found **I Write What I Like** contains a selection of Biko's writings from 1969 when he became the president of the South African Students Organization to 1972 when he was prohibited from publishing The collection also includes a preface by Archbishop Desmond Tutu an introduction by Malusi and Thoko Mpumlwana who were both involved with Biko in the Black Consciousness movement a memoir of Biko by Father Aelred Stubbs his longtime pastor and friend and a new foreword by Professor Lewis Gordon Biko's writings will inspire and educate anyone concerned with issues of racism postcolonialism and black nationalism

African Music, Power, and Being in Colonial Zimbabwe Mhoze Chikowero, 2015-11-24 In this new history of music in Zimbabwe Mhoze Chikowero deftly uses African sources to interrogate the copious colonial archive reading it as a confessional voice along and against the grain to write a complex history of music colonialism and African self liberation Chikowero's book begins in the 1890s with missionary crusades against African performative cultures and African students being inducted into mission bands which contextualize the music of segregated urban and mining company dance halls in the 1930s and he builds genealogies of the Chimurenga music later popularized by guerrilla artists like Dorothy Masuku Zexie Manatsa Thomas Mapfumo and others in the 1970s Chikowero shows how Africans deployed their music and indigenous knowledge systems to fight for their freedom from British colonial domination and to assert their cultural sovereignty

The Work of Repair Thomas Cousins, 2023-06-06 In the timber plantations in northeastern South Africa laborers work long hours among tall swaying lines of eucalypts on land once theirs In 2008 at the height of the HIV AIDS crisis timber corporations distributed hot cooked meals as a nutrition intervention to bolster falling productivity and profits But life and sustenance are about much more than calories and machinic bodies What is at stake is the nurturing of capacity across all domains of life physical relational cosmological in the form of amandla An Nguni word meaning power strength or capacity amandla organizes ordinary concerns with one's abilities to earn a wage to strengthen one's body and to take care of others it describes the potency of medicines and sexual vitality and it captures a history of anti colonial and anti apartheid struggle for freedom The ordinary actions coordinated by and directed at amandla do not obscure the wounding effects of plantation labor or the long history of racial oppression but rather form the basis of what the Algerian artist Kader Attia calls repair In this captivating ethnography Cousins examines how amandla as the primary material of the work of repair anchors ordinary scenes of living and working in and around the plantations As a space of exploitation that enables the global paper and packaging industry to extract labor power the plantation depends on the availability of creative action in ordinary life to capitalize on bodily capacity The Work of Repair is a fine grained exploration of the relationships between laborers in the timber plantations of KwaZulu Natal and the historical decompositions and reinventions of the milieu of those livelihoods and lives Offering a fresh approach to the existential ethical and political stakes of ethnography from and of late liberal South Africa the book attends to urgent questions of postapartheid life the fate of employment the role of the state in providing welfare and access to treatment the regulation of popular curatives the queering of kinship and the future of custom and its territories Through detailed descriptions Cousins explicates the important and fragile techniques that constitute the work of repair the effort to augment one's capacity in a way that draws on acknowledges and reimagines the wounds of history keeping open the possibility of a future through and with others

Hegel and the Third World Teshale Tibebu, 2011-02-02 Hegel more than any other modern Western philosopher produced the most systematic case for the superiority of Western white Protestant bourgeois modernity He established a racially structured ladder of gradation of the peoples of the world putting Germanic people at the top of the racial pyramid people of Asia in the middle and Africans and Indigenous people of the Americas and Pacific Islands at the bottom In *Hegel and the Third World* Tibebu guides the reader through Hegel s presentation on universalism to argue that such a classification flows in part from Hegel s philosophy of the development of

human consciousness Hegel classified Africans as people arrested at the lowest and most immediate stage of consciousness that of the senses Asians as people with divided consciousness that of the understanding and Europeans as people of reason Tibebu demonstrates that Hegel's views were not his alone but reflected the fundamental beliefs of other major figures of Western thought at the time With detailed analysis and thorough research Hegel and the Third World challenges the central idea of Hegel's philosophy of history progress In addition Tibebu succeeds in providing a fascinating critique of the Western philosopher's rationalization of the gradual decline suffered by the people of the Third World in the context of modern world history

Desegregating the Past Robyn Autry, 2017-02-07 At the Apartheid Museum in Johannesburg South Africa visitors confront the past upon arrival They must decide whether to enter the museum through a door marked whites or another marked non whites Inside along with text they encounter hanging nooses and other reminders of apartheid era atrocities In the United States museum exhibitions about racial violence and segregation are mostly confined to black history museums with national history museums sidelining such difficult material Even the Smithsonian's National Museum of African American History and Culture is dedicated not to violent histories of racial domination but to a more generalized narrative about black identity and culture The scale at which violent racial pasts have been incorporated into South African national historical narratives is lacking in the U S *Desegregating the Past* considers why this is the case tracking the production and display of historical representations of racial pasts at museums in both countries and what it reveals about underlying social anxieties unsettled emotions and aspirations surrounding contemporary social fault lines around race Robyn Autry consults museum archives conducts interviews with staff and recounts the public and private battles fought over the creation and content of history museums Despite vast differences in the development of South African and U S society Autry finds a common set of ideological political economic and institutional dilemmas arising out of the selective reconstruction of the past Museums have played a major role in shaping public memory at times recognizing and at other times blurring the ongoing influence of historical crimes The narratives museums produce to engage with difficult violent histories expose present anxieties concerning identity mis recognition and ongoing conflict

Political Blackness in Multiracial Britain Mohan Ambikaipaker, 2018-06-29 One evening in 1980 a group of white friends drinking at the Duke of Edinburgh pub on East Ham High Street made a monstrous five pound wager The first person to kill a Paki would win the bet Ali Akhtar Baig a young Pakistani student who lived in the east London borough of Newham was their chosen victim Baig's murder was but one incident in a wave of antiblack racial attacks that were commonplace during the crisis of race relations in Britain in the 1970s and 1980s Ali Akhtar Baig's death also catalyzed the formation of a grassroots antiracist organization Newham Monitoring Project NMP that worked to transform the racist victimization of African African Caribbean and South Asian communities into campaigns for racial justice and social change In addition to providing a 24 hour hotline and casework services NMP activists worked to mitigate the scourge of racial injustice that included daily racial harassment hate crimes

and antiblack police violence Since the advent of the War on Terror NMP widened its approach to support victims of the state's counterterror policies which have contributed to an unfettered surge in Islamophobia These realities as well as the many layers of gendered racism in contemporary Britain come to life through intimate ethnographic storytelling The reader gets to know a broad range of east Londoners and antiracist activists whose intersecting experiences present a multifaceted portrait of British racism Mohan Ambikaipaker examines the life experiences of these individuals through a strong theoretical lens that combines critical race theory and postcolonial studies Political Blackness in Multiracial Britain shows how the deep processes of everyday political whiteness shape the state's failure to provide effective remedies for ethnic racial and religious minorities who continue to face violence and institutional racism *Neither Settler nor Native* Mahmood
