The core chapters also describe the strategies used by prevailing Spanish speakers to gain new speakers among the indigenous and Afro-Hispanic populations such as the appropriation of public posts where the need arose to file documents in both Spanish and Nahuatl, forced and free labor in agriculture, construction and the textile industry. The examples of optimal and popular residual variants illustrate the trends unfolded during three centuries of colonial life.
