La estrategia de Chochueca Rita Indiana Hernández, 2003 En La estrategia de Chochueca la capital dominicana se convierte en protagonista de lo narrado La ciudad funciona simultáneamente como referente y eje vertebrador para los sujetos que la habitan y que se articulan como tal en esa íntima relación de interdependencia con el espacio urbano del Santo Domingo de fin de milenio El personaje de Silvia domina la narración de principio a fin El acto aparentemente trivial de la entrega de unas bocinas robadas de un concierto pone en evidencia la existencia de un Santo Domingo subterráneo y marginal habitado por identidades subalternas Estos sujetos de la diferencia la juventud dominicana de los años noventa de diversos estratos sociales pugnan por afincar en el imaginario urbano a la vez que escapan con narcóticos drogas alcohol música y misantropía de esa cotidianidad social que no los apercibe A pesar de la aparente liviandad de sus impresiones la narradora demuestra un obsesivo afán sociológico Cada una de sus andanzas por la ciudad capital viene aparejada por algún tipo de reflexión sobre la realidad urbana circundante y los sujetos que la integran En ocasiones este gesto implica una postura de cinismo frente a lo histórico mediante la cual se convoca el pasado no para reconstruirlo a través de un proceso exegético sino para parodiar y a la vez degradar el peso de ese discurso matriz de la nación que lo sustenta como monumento En La estrategia la historia dista mucho de ser el elemento aglutinante fundamental en la configuración del ideal patrio que está supuesto a ser asimilado por los individuos como un principio irrefutable Por el contrario el pasado monumental constituye junto a la jerga de la subcultura de la juventud dominicana y los productos de la cultura massmediática uno de los elementos que participan en el proceso cognitivo de la narradora por la geografía urbana Tanto Silvia como las demás figuras que pueblan el texto constituyen subjetividades múltiples que acentúan la prevalencia de lo híbrido y lo fragmentario en sus esquemas vitales Ciertamente la preeminencia de la discursividad social el lenguaje callejero y la parodia de los iconos culturales en esta novela evidencian la presencia de nuevas figuraciones de los sujetos surgidos en el proceso histórico dominicano actual
