Evidence-based practice is, as the name suggests, the idea that occupational practices should be based on scientific evidence.

OVERVIEW

Supporters of evidence-based practice claim that it can to bridge the gap between research and practical application. Evidence-based practices distinguish between research that has immediate practical significance and research that doesn't.

- Play-Based Learning: learning theorists in the early- to mid-20th Century presented evidence that play-based learning supports children's cognitive development, which has affected curriculum development worldwide.
