endpoints but in more sophisticated graph structures edges can be associated with a direction or assigned a label Graph vertices can be labeled as well A graph can be represented graphically as a drawing vertex dot edge arc but as long as every pair of adjacent points stays connected by the same edge the graph vertices can be moved around on a drawing without changing the underlying graph structure The expressive power of the graph models placing a special emphasis on connectivity between objects has made them the models of choice in chemistry physics biology and other fields
