The third category new elites is actually intended to destabilize the other two denying any essential Roman or African identity. Thereafter samples from Tertullian's writings serve to illustrate comparisons of his own identities and the identities of his rhetorical opponents. The overall study finds Tertullian's identities to be manifold complex and discursive. Additionally his writings are understood to reflect antagonism toward Romans including Christian Romans which is significant for his so called Montanism and Romanized Africans. While Tertullian accommodates much from Graeco Roman literature laws and customs he nevertheless retains a strongly stated non Roman-ness and an African-ity which is highlighted in the present monograph.
