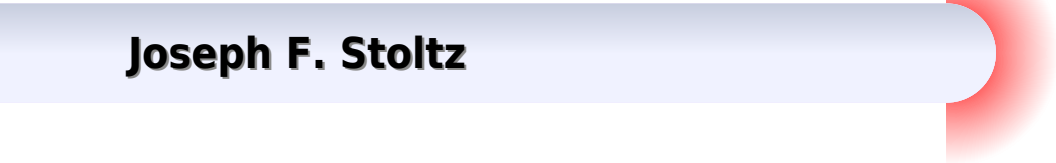

Thomas Sully frequented Independence Square when Philadelphia served as the nation's capital during the 1790s and portraitist Charles Willson Peale merged the arts, sciences and public interest when he transformed a portion of the hall into a center for natural science in 1802. In the 1850s, hearings for accused fugitive slaves who faced the loss of freedom were held ironically in this famous birthplace of American independence. Over the years, Philadelphians have used the old state house and its public square in a multitude of ways that have transformed it into an arena of conflict. Labor grievances have echoed regularly in Independence Square since the 1830s, while civil rights protesters exercised their right to free speech in the turbulent 1960s. As much as the Founding Fathers, these people and events illuminate the building's significance as a cultural symbol.

Protecting Suburban America Denise Lawrence-Zuniga, 2020-06-07 *Protecting Suburban America* explores the dynamics and conflicts inherent in preserving historic twentieth-century suburban landscapes in America.
