Avian diseases are also critically important to the conservation of endemic bird species in many places around the world. Parasite bird interactions are also increasingly occurring in rapidly changing global environments thus their ecology is also changing and this shapes the complex ways by which parasites influence the inter connected health of birds humans and shared ecosystems Given the key role of birds in ecological communities more broadly and as the primary host to so many zoonotic pathogens an understanding of the ecological and evolutionary principles underlying the maintenance amplification transmission and dispersal of these infectious agents is crucial to understanding how to mitigate the negative global impacts of the ever increasing number of emerging infectious diseases Although the topics and principles discussed in this book relate to birds they have a far wider relevance and can also be applied to non avian wildlife host pathogen systems The COVID 19 pandemic has shown that understanding of disease ecology in wild animal populations is paramount to global health
