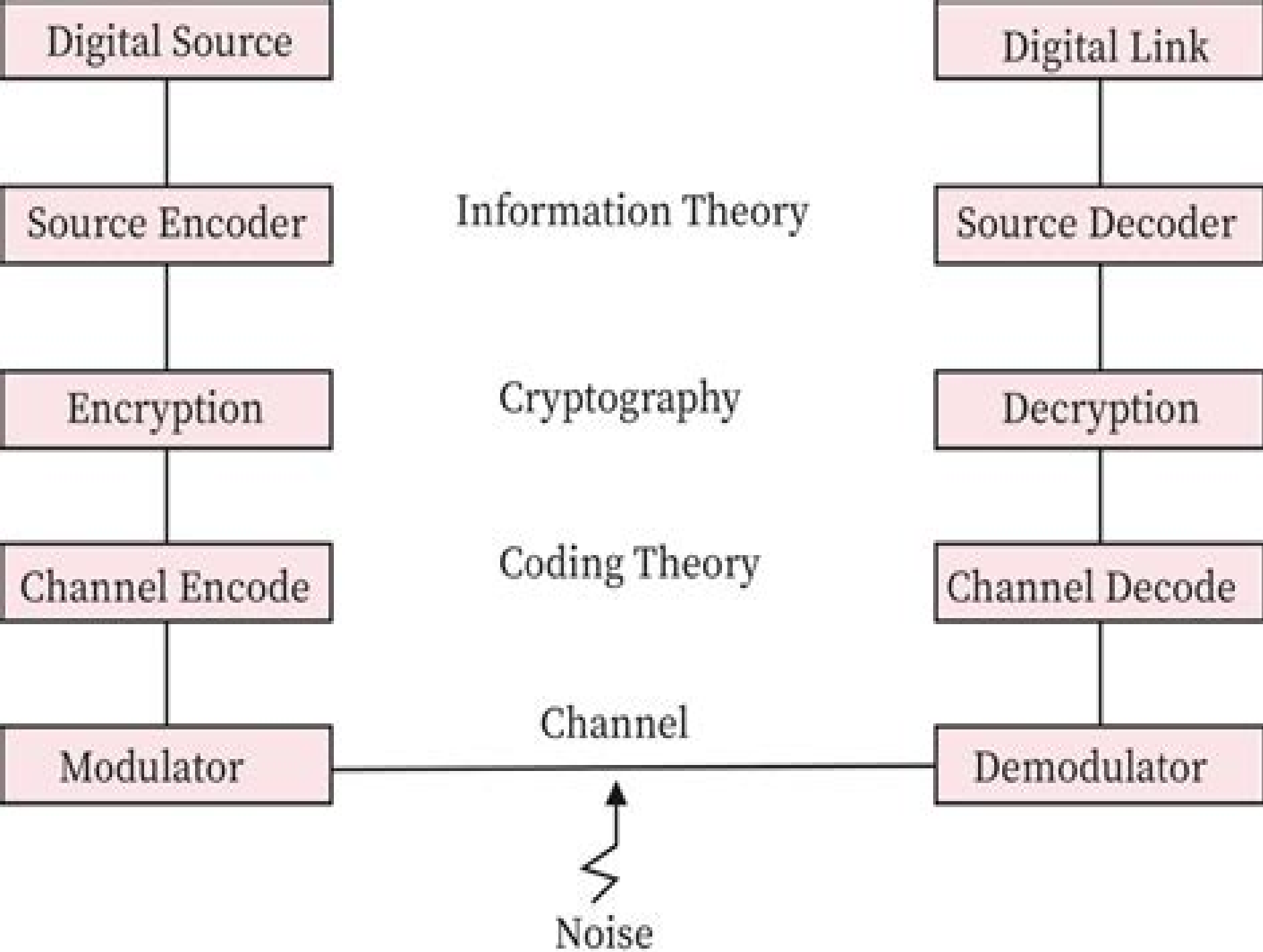




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Introduction to Coding and Information Theory Steven Roman, 1996-11-26 This book is intended to introduce coding theory and information theory to undergraduate students of mathematics and computer science It begins with a review of probability theory as applied to finite sample spaces and a general introduction to the nature and types of codes The two subsequent chapters discuss information theory efficiency of codes the entropy of information sources and Shannon's Noiseless Coding Theorem The remaining three chapters deal with coding theory communication channels decoding in the presence of errors the general theory of linear codes and such specific codes as Hamming codes the simplex codes and many others

Information Theory and Coding - Solved Problems Predrag Ivaniš, Dušan Drajić, 2016-11-29 This book offers a comprehensive overview of information theory and error control coding using a different approach than in existed literature The chapters are organized according to the Shannon system model where one block affects the others A relatively brief theoretical introduction is provided at the beginning of every chapter including a few additional examples and explanations but without any proofs And a short overview of some aspects of abstract algebra is given at the end of the corresponding chapters The characteristic complex examples with a lot of illustrations and tables are chosen to provide detailed insights into the nature of the problem Some limiting cases are presented to illustrate the connections with the theoretical bounds The numerical values are carefully selected to provide in depth explanations of the described algorithms Although the examples in the different chapters can be considered separately they are mutually connected and the conclusions for one considered problem relate to the others in the book

Coding and Information Theory Steven Roman, 1992-06-04 This book is an introduction to information and coding theory at the graduate or advanced undergraduate level It assumes a basic knowledge of probability and modern algebra but is otherwise self contained The intent is to describe as clearly as possible the fundamental issues involved in these subjects rather than covering all aspects in an encyclopedic fashion The first quarter of the book is devoted to information theory including a proof of Shannon's famous Noisy Coding Theorem The remainder of the book is devoted to coding theory and is independent of the information theory portion of the book After a brief discussion of general families of codes the author discusses linear codes including the Hamming Golay the

Gray, 2012-12-06 Source coding theory has as its goal the characterization of the optimal performance achievable in idealized communication systems which must code an information source for transmission over a digital communication or storage channel for transmission to a user The user must decode the information into a form that is a good approximation to the original A code is optimal within some class if it achieves the best possible fidelity given whatever constraints are imposed on the code by the available channel In theory the primary constraint imposed on a code by the channel is its rate or resolution

the number of bits per second or per input symbol that it can transmit from sender to receiver In the real world complexity may be as important as rate The origins and the basic form of much of the theory date from Shannon's classical development of noiseless source coding and source coding subject to a fidelity criterion also called rate distortion theory 73 74 Shannon combined a probabilistic notion of information with limit theorems from ergodic theory and a random coding technique to describe the optimal performance of systems with a constrained rate but with unconstrained complexity and delay An alternative approach called asymptotic or high rate quantization theory based on different techniques and approximations was introduced by Bennett at approximately the same time 4 This approach constrained the delay but allowed the rate to grow large
