King Richard II William Shakespeare, 2014-09-25 This richly annotated edition takes a fresh look at the first part of Shakespeare's second tetralogy of history plays showing how it relates to the other plays in the sequence Forker places the play in its political context discussing its relation to competing theories of monarchy looking at how it faced censorship because of possible comparisons between Richard II and Elizabeth I and how Bolingbroke's rebellion could be compared to the Essex rising of the time This edition also reconsiders Shakespeare's use of sources asking why he chose to emphasise one approach over another Forker also looks at the play's rich afterlife and the many interpretations that actors and directors have taken Finally the edition looks closely at the aesthetic relationship between language character structure and political import

Gimelli Martin, Hassan Melehy, 2016-04-15 The study of literature still tends to be nation based even when direct evidence contradicts longstanding notions of an autonomous literary canon In a time when current events make inevitable the acceptance of a global perspective the essays in this volume suggest a corrective to such scholarly limitations the contributors offer alternatives to received notions of influence and the more or less linear transmission of *translatio studii* demonstrating that they no longer provide adequate explanations for the interactions among the various literary canons of the Renaissance Offering texts on a variety of aspects of the Anglo French Renaissance instead of concentrating on one set of borrowings or phenomena this collection points to new configurations of the relationships among national literatures Contributors address specific borrowings rewritings and appropriations of French writing by English authors in fields ranging from lyric poetry to epic poetry to drama to political treatise The bibliography presents a comprehensive list of publications on French connections in the English Renaissance from 1902 to the present day

Shakespeare's Wordplay and Possible Worlds Georgi Niagolov, Shakespeare's Wordplay and Possible Worlds proposes a novel possible world approach to the complex interpretative potential of Shakespeare's wordplay The approach is based on the observation that in Shakespeare multiple significations of ambiguous words or syntactic structures often cohere with other apparently unambiguous words or syntactic structures and thus project parallel cognitive scenarios Therefore the use of possible worlds as cognitive tools allows the exploration of such scenarios in their broadest context and at the same time provides insight into the conceptual blending that occurs between and among them The book demonstrates the utility of the proposed theoretical construct for textual and cultural analysis in three illustrative case studies

Shakespeare and Religion Alison Shell, 2014-09-22 This book sets Shakespeare in the religious context of his times presenting a balanced up to date account of current biographical and critical debates and addressing the fascinating under studied topic of how Shakespeare's writing was perceived by literary contemporaries both Catholic and Protestant whose priorities were more obviously religious than his own It advances new readings of several plays especially Hamlet King Lear and The Winter's Tale these draw in many cases on new and under exploited contemporary analogues ranging from conversion narratives books of devotion and polemical pamphlets to manuscript drama and emblems Shakespeare's writing has been seen both as profoundly religious giving everyday human life a sacramental quality and as profoundly secular foreshadowing the kind of humanism that sees no
