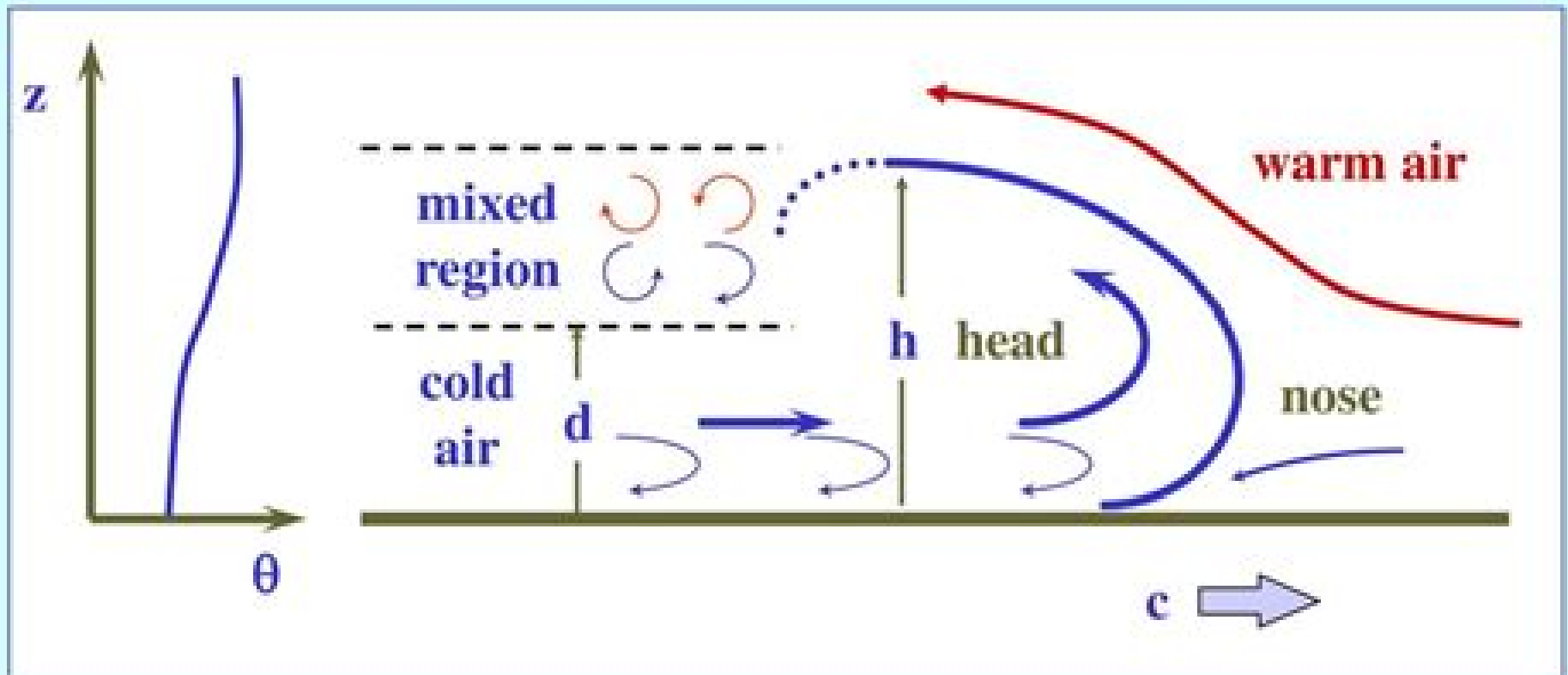

Peakall, 2009-03-05 This volume arises from the conference Sediment Transport and Deposition by Particulate Gravity Currents held in the UK in 1998 The field of particulate gravity currents ranges from turbidity currents in the oceans lakes and reservoirs to pyroclastic density currents and avalanches debris flows and lahars grain flows powder snow avalanches effluent dispersal and ancient gravity current deposits Although the sub division of particulate gravity currents into discrete sub categories such as grain flows turbidity currents or debris flows provides a convenient descriptive shorthand it undermines the sense of process continuum needed to describe many natural flows The structure of this volume reflects an integrative aim with papers grouped by research approach The first section of the book

contains six papers on theoretical and numerical modelling of a range of flow types. The following four papers are focused upon combined theoretical and experimental modelling approaches. The next section contains four papers describing experimental modelling and the final section includes five papers detailing field based studies. The volume stands as a testament to the broad range of research carried out on particulate gravity currents and hints at the enhanced rate of progress that is likely to be achieved through further integrated studies. **Interaction Between Dense Gravity Currents and Internal Waves** Yukinobu Tanimoto, 2021. Gravity currents are flows driven by horizontal density gradients. A dense gravity current is a specific type of gravity current where the density of the fluid is higher than that of the ambient, making the gravity current negatively buoyant. When the receiving ambient is stratified, the ultimate fate and transport of a dense gravity current becomes more complex. We consider a two-layer stratification representative of a stratified water column in lakes and in the near coastal environment. Using laboratory experiments, the interaction between dense gravity currents and internal waves are considered. Internal waves are observed to be generated by the gravity current and their behavior in at shorter and longer time scales are quantified. Oncoming internal waves were also introduced which acted to hinder the mass flux of a portion of the split gravity current.

**Experimental and Numerical Studies on Two-dimensional Gravity Currents in a Horizontal Channel** W. R. Chan, E. E. Zukoski, Toshi Kubota, California Institute of Technology. Division of Engineering and Applied Science, Center for Fire Research (U.S.), Daniel and Florence Guggenheim Jet Propulsion Center, 1993. The objective of this investigation is to examine the behavior of two-dimensional gravity currents especially as applied to the spreading of smoke generated from a room fire along a long corridor. Both experimental and numerical techniques were used to provide a model that can adequately explain and predict the behavior of a gravity current under certain boundary conditions. A series of experiments was carried out to study the effects of Reynolds number on gravity currents in a horizontal water channel. Measurements of the time-varying front position, velocity profile of the following current and the depth of a gravity current were made using either dyed liquids or hydrogen bubble technique. Quantitative results were shown to agree with previously published results. A model was put forth to bridge the gap between the existing models for an inertia-buoyancy dominated gravity current and a viscous-buoyancy dominated one. Comparison between the experimental results and numerical results obtained from the model proved that the model can adequately explain the behavior of the phenomenon. A second series of experiments was conducted to investigate the behavior of gravity currents in an inclined channel. The quantitative results obtained were less scattered than those obtained in previous research. The gravity current was found to be unsteady in a horizontal channel while a channel with an angle of inclination of one degree was found to produce a steady flow behind the front of the gravity current. The change of the gravity currents from an unsteady to a steady

nature due to the change in the inclination of the channel was found to be gradual and much less abrupt than assumed in previous studies

**Gravity Currents Propagating Upslope in Uniform and Two-layer Stratified Ambients** Larissa J. Marleau, 2014

Bottom propagating gravity currents resulting from full and partial depth lock release experiments are investigated as they propagate up a rising slope in uniform and two layer stratified ambients In the case of uniform ambients the gravity current front decelerates in a nearly uniform manner along the slope at a rate that agrees with theoretical predictions The shape of the gravity current as it decelerates over relatively steep slopes is found to be self similar with a nearly linear decrease of the head height between the start of the slope and up to 80 % of the distance to the nose Some deviation from self similar behaviour is found in cases with small slopes because of the comparatively large volume of fluid in the gravity current tail that flows downslope while the front continues to advance upwards In the case of two layer ambients the initial gravity current front speed is found to be consistent with a theory adapted from cite shin\_dalziel\_linden2004 The subsequent evolution depends on the gravity current speed relative to the speed of the interfacial disturbance it creates The deceleration of supercritical gravity currents which travel faster than the interfacial disturbance is gradual and agrees well with the relationship developed for upslope gravity currents in uniform density ambients and modified for a two layer ambient In most subcritical cases the gravity current suddenly comes to rest as a consequence of interactions with the interfacial disturbance The disturbance amplitude speed and width are found to be nearly constant during its evolution In cases for which the ambient interface intersected the tank bottom the amplitude speed and width are nearly constant up to the point where the lower layer shallowed and the disturbance transformed into an upslope propagating gravity current
