

THE COELACANTH

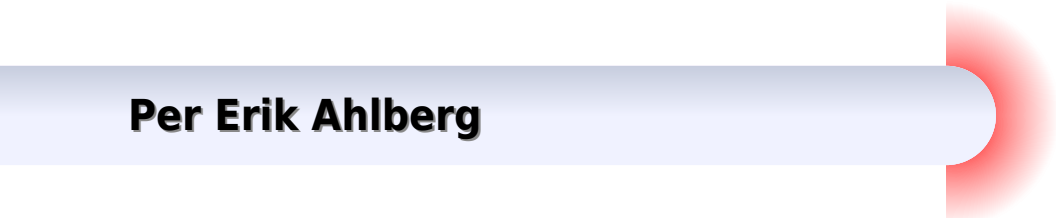
