1. Describe the events of the evening of August 4, 1789

On August 4, 1789, a number of noblemen gave rousing addresses in which they proclaimed their love for liberty and equality,

2. What are 3 main points in the Declaration of the Rights of Man?

The three basic tenets of the Declaration of Human Rights are freedom, property rights, and the right to oppose persecution.

3. How does the slogan "Liberty, Equality, Fraternity" sum up the goals of the revolution?

It is the necessity for France to be united, for all citizens to have equal rights and treatment, and for emancipation from previous class structures.

4. How did the National Assembly actions affect the Catholic Church?

Church leaders and priests were ordered to be elected and compensated like state officials when the assembly confiscated church properties. As a result, the Catholic Church lost both its political independence and its holdings.

5. Why was the Assembly hesitant to further tax the Bourgeoisie?

France had debt that needed to be paid off, and they were using high taxes and excribitant costs to accomplish so. They were reluctant to impose additional taxes on the bourgeoisis since they already taxed them excessively and more heavily than other estates, and they feared a third estate uprising against them.

6. Why did the Assembly's actions anger the peasants and how would this affect future revolutionary action?

They detested the estate system because it kept them at the bottom and benefited the wealthy elite. Future revolutions would be impacted by this. It urged that the monarch implement economic reforms to guarantee that the populace had access to food. This group was known as the "3rd estate" and represented France's common people.

7. Why did Louis XIV and his family try to escape France?

Louis XVI reflected on his future as a king. Some of his advisers alerted him to the danger his family and he were in. Many monarchy supporters left France because they believed it to be unsafe. The royal family then attempted to flee France for the Austrian Natherlands in June 1791. However, as they got close to the border, they were stopped and taken back to Paris under supervision.

What type of government did the National Assembly create in 1791 and how would power be distributed?

The national assembly established a constitutional monarchy in 1791, with the elected parliament having the authority to pass and implement laws while the king served as the head of state.

Summarize the three general groups of the Legislative Assembly: (Radicals, Moderates, and Conservatives).

Radicals are those who want a radical overhaul of the social order or the entire political system (Set on the left) The moderates sought certain governmental changes, but fewer than the extremists (set in the middle) Conservatives supported the nation of a limited monarchy and favored little changes to the current system of governance (set on right)

10. Why did the Legislative Assembly declare war on Austria?

Following Austria's refusal to withdraw its troops from the French border and to retract its alleged threat to use force, When Austria and Prussia responded to France's declaration of war in the spring of 1792 with a concerted invasion, it was ultimately regulsed in the Battle of Volmy in September.

11. Why did Parisians imprison the Royal Family?

The newly established legislative assembly aimed to spread the uprising over all of Europe. France declared war on Austria in Agril 1792, Louis XVI was blamed for how poorly the war went. He lost his title and was sent in jail after being charged with treason.
